Maple Ridge A five-part pattern part 2

Leaf block

CUTTING

From the assorted oranges:

40 squares 4" x 4" (A)

60 squares 31/2" x 31/2" (B)

From the cream:

40 squares 4" x 4" (A)

20 squares 31/2" x 31/2" (B)

40 squares 3" x 3" (C)


From the brown:

20 squares 31/2" x 31/2" (B)



Block assembly

Following the instructions for making HSTs in part 1, make 80 HSTs using the orange and cream A squares.



HSTs - Make 80.

To make the stem unit, first draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the cream C squares. Place a C square on the corner of a brown B square, right sides together. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim to ¼" from the stitching. Press seam allowances toward the center.







Sew one side of stem.


Place a C square on the opposite corner and repeat. Make 20 stem units.






Complete the stem - Make 20.

Following the figure, lay out a block using 1 cream B square, 1 stem unit, 4 orange/cream HSTs and 3 orange B squares. Sew the squares and units into block rows. Press seam allowances in the direction of the arrows. Sew the block rows together. The block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " from raw edge to raw edge.



Leaf block assembly


Make 20 leaf blocks.



Leaf block - Make 20.

Adding the border

Referring to the figure for correct block orientation, sew 2 Leaf blocks together for a side border. Press all seam allowances in the direction of the arrows. Make 2. Sew to the sides of the House block. Sew 4 Leaf blocks together for the top border. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. There will be 8 Leaf blocks left over.



Add Leaf blocks to House block.
