Maple Ridge

A five-part pattern *part 3*

Frodo & Frodo corner blocks

CUTTING for Frodo Blocks

From the dark cream:

32 squares 4" x 4" (A)

From the dark purple:

32 squares 4" x 4" (A)

From the blue:

16 squares 3½" x 3½" (B)

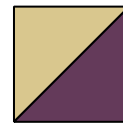
From the green:

6 strips 2" x WOF

From the burgundy:

6 strips 2" x WOF

Following the instructions for making HSTs in part 1, make 64 HSTs using the dark purple and dark cream A squares.

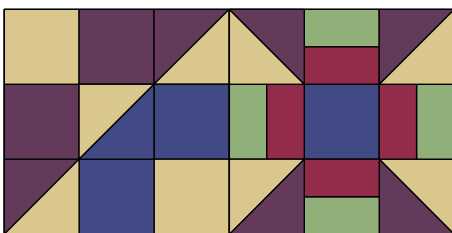


HSTs – Make 64.

Referring to the tips for making strip sets in part 1, pair up a green and a burgundy strip, right sides together. Stitch along the long edge. Press seam allowances toward the burgundy strip. Subcut each strip set into 3½" segments. Cut 64, sewing additional strip sets as needed.



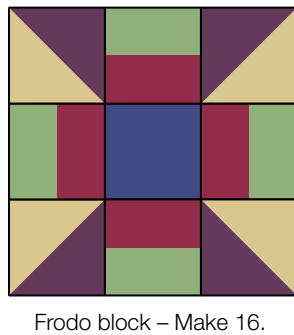
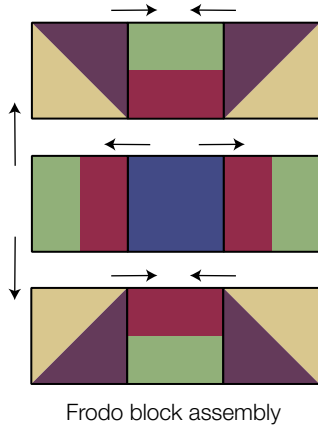
Strip-sets - Subcut into 64 segments.



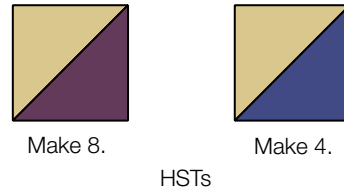
Following the figure, lay out a block using 1 blue B square, 4 strip set segments, and 4 dark purple/dark cream HSTs. Sew the squares and units into block rows. Press seam allowances in

the direction of the arrows. Sew the block rows together. The block should measure 9½" x 9½" from raw edge to raw edge.

Make 16 Frodo blocks.

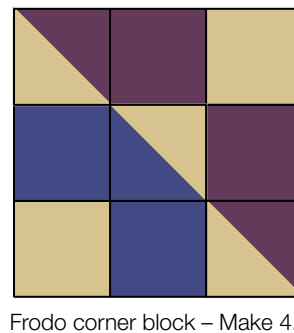
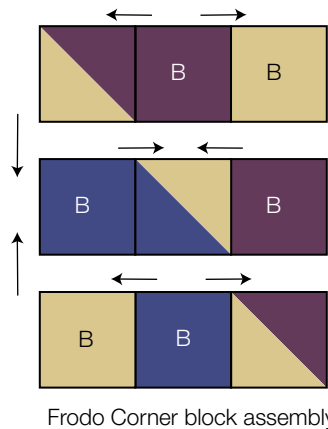


Following the instructions for making HSTs in part 1, make 8 HSTs using dark purple and dark cream A squares, and 4 HSTs using blue and dark cream A squares.



Following the figure, lay out a block using 2 blue B squares, 2 dark purple B squares, 2 dark cream B squares, 2 dark purple/dark cream HSTs, and 1 blue/dark cream HST. Sew the squares and units into block rows. Press seam allowances in the direction of the arrows. Sew the block rows together. The block should measure 9½" x 9½" from raw edge to raw edge.

Make 4 Frodo corner blocks.



CUTTING for Frodo Corner Blocks

From the dark cream:

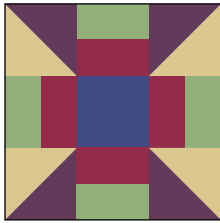
- 6 squares 4" x 4" (A)
- 8 squares 3½" x 3½" (B)

From the dark purple:


- 4 squares 4" x 4" (A)
- 8 squares 3½" x 3½" (B)

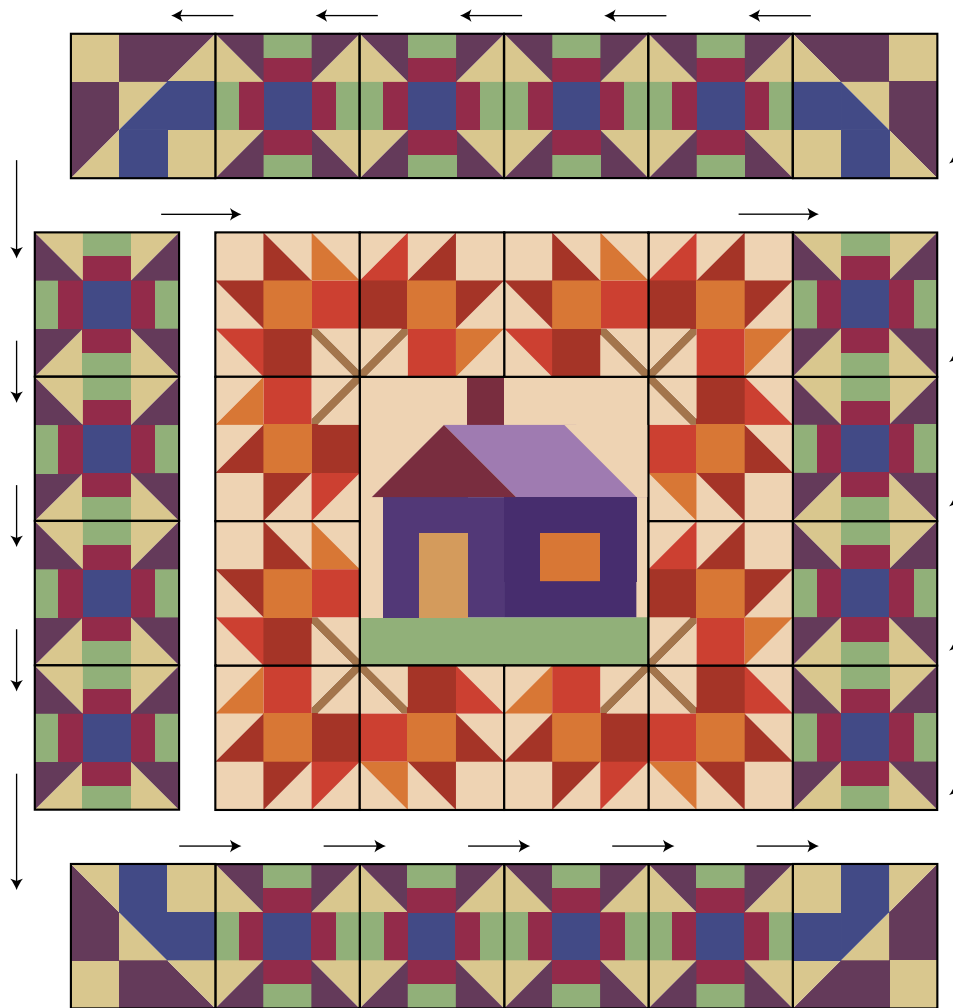
From the blue:

- 2 squares 4" x 4" (A)
- 8 squares 3½" x 3½" (B)



Adding the border

Referring to the figure for correct block orientation, sew 4 Frodo blocks together to make one pieced border strip. Press all seam allowances in the direction of the arrows. Make 4. Sew two pieced border strips to the sides of the quilt center. Sew Frodo Corner blocks to each end of the remaining border strips. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. 



Add Frodo blocks border to quilt.
