# Maple Ridge

A five-part pattern *part 5*

## Border blocks

### CUTTING

From the cream:

9 strips 2" x WOF

56 squares 4" x 4" (A)

56 squares 3½" x 3½" (B)

From the dark purple:

56 squares 4" x 4" (A)

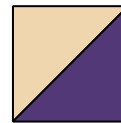
From the dark ruby red:

9 strips 2" x WOF



## Block assembly

Following the instructions for making HSTs in part 1, make 112 HSTs using dark purple and cream A squares.



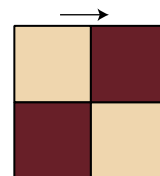
HSTs – Make 112.

Referring to the tips for making strip sets in part 1, pair up a cream and a dark ruby red strip, right sides together. Stitch along the long edge. Press seam allowances toward the dark ruby red strip. Subcut each strip set into 2" segments. Cut 168 segments (sew additional strip sets as needed.)



Strip-sets – Subcut into 168 segments.

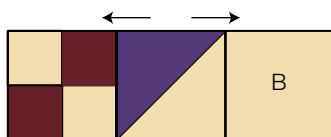
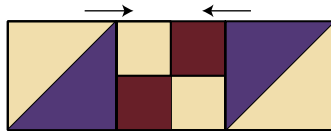
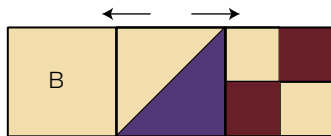
Join 2 segments to make a Four-patch unit. Make 84.



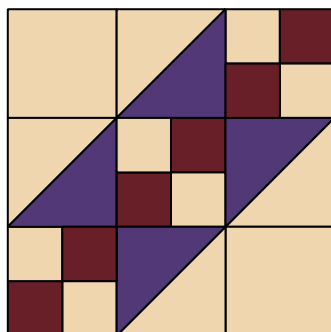
Four-patch units – Make 84.

Following the figure, lay out a block using 2 cream B squares, 3 four-patch units, and 4 dark purple/cream HSTs. Sew the squares and units into block rows. Press seam allowances in the direction of the arrows. Sew the block rows together. The block should measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " from raw edge to raw edge.

Make 28 border blocks.



Border block assembly

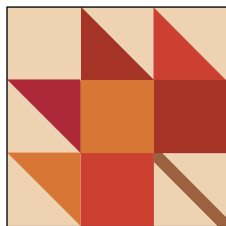


Border block - Make 28.

### Adding the border


Referring to the figure for correct block orientation and placement, join 8 border blocks for a side border. Press all seam allowances in the direction of the arrows. Make 2. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Join 2 Leaf blocks and 6 border blocks for the top border. Repeat for the bottom border. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

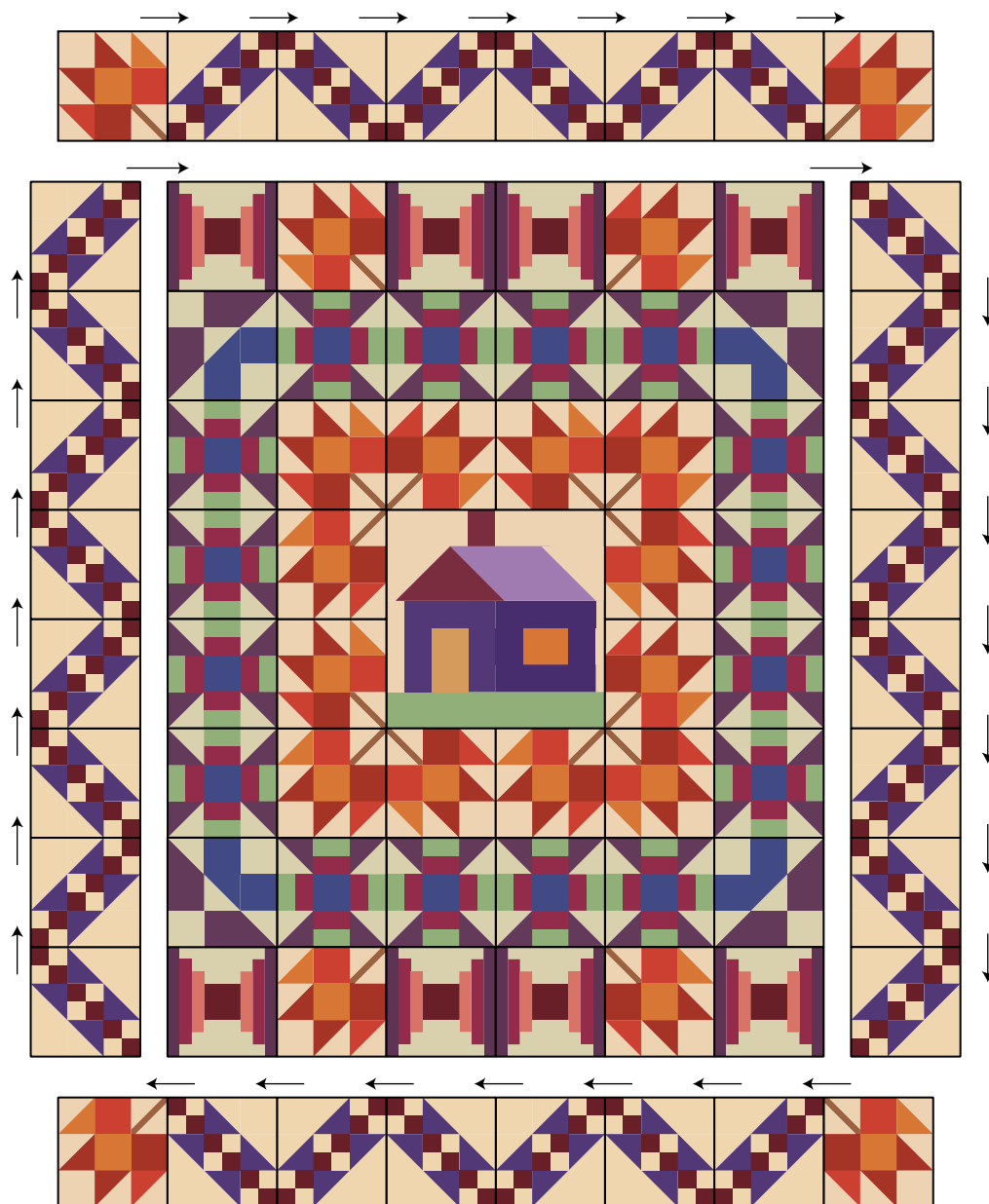




### Quilting & finishing

Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste to secure. Our quilt is quilted with an all-over design of flowers and leaves.

From the binding fabric, cut 9 strips  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF. Sew the binding strips together for 334" of continuous binding. Finish the edges of your quilt with double-fold binding. 



Add border block/Leaf block border to quilt.

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
