



## Creole Puzzle








Creole Puzzle Piecing

## Fabric and cutting requirements for each Creole Puzzle block:


Light blue-green	3" x 14½" scrap	4 B, 2 D
Medium red	3" x 141/2" scrap	4 Br, 2 D
Dark red	5½" x 9" scrap	patch 1 of foundation-pieced unit*, 2 A
Medium blue-green	5½" x 9" scrap	patch 1 of foundation-pieced unit*, 2 A
Light purple	6½" x 11½" scrap	patches 2 and 3 of foundation-pieced unit*, 4 C



\*In place of dark red, medium blue-green, and light purple fabrics for the foundation-pieced units, you may use 1 fabric that has stripes that are 1½"—2" wide. Use the foundation-piecing pattern as a template to fussy cut 4 triangles from the striped fabric.

## Rotary cutting:

A = 47/8'' square cut in half diagonally



 $D = 2^{1}/2^{\prime\prime}$  square



If you are not using a striped fabric for the corner triangles, make 2 foundation-pieced units, placing the dark red and the medium blue-green fabrics as shown.


Transfer the dots from the B and Br templates onto the wrong side of the patches. Sew a B to a Br, starting at the raw edge opposite the dots, stopping at the dots, and backstitching at both ends. Repeat to make 4 B/Br units.

Referring to the piecing diagram, join the B/Br units and C patches, starting the stitches at the dots and backstitching at both ends. Join the corner triangles, the B/Br/C units, and the D patches in horizontal rows. Join the rows. TQL



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
