Fabric and cutting requirements for each Two Colors block:

Light teal	6" x 30" scrap	8 A, 4 D
Red	2 ³ / ₄ " x 10 ¹ / ₂ " scrap	4 A
Medium teal	5 ¹ / ₂ " x 9 ¹ / ₂ " scrap	4 B
Tan	5 ¹ / ₂ " x 13 ¹ / ₂ " scrap	4 C

Rotary cutting:

- A = 2¹/₂" square
- B = 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangle
- C = 2¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" rectangle
- D = 4¹/₂" square

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a light teal A patch. With right sides together, place the A in the corner of a

medium teal B with the diagonal line running from top left to bottom right. Stitch on the line. Trim ¹/₄" from the seam line. Discard the 2 small "waste" triangles. Open the A and press seam allowances toward the B. Make 3 more Fast 45 Unit 1's like this.

Repeat the process to make a Fast 45 Unit 2 with a red A, a light teal A, and a tan C, with the diagonal lines of the A's running from top right to bottom left. Make 3 more Fast 45 Unit 2's like this.

Follow the piecing diagram to join the Fast 45 units and the D patches in the order shown. [TQL](#)
