


Weave a lattice piecrust



Quilt assembly—no problem! But a lattice piecrust? Still no problem! Print these easy directions to go along with Alex's recipe for Door County Best Cherry Pie (and for future reference). You'll find the ingredients and the general directions in "Cook-off" in the April 2012 issue of The Quilt Life.





- a Using the half-inch strips of dough that you cut according to the recipe, position 5 strips over the pie about 1" apart.
- b Fold back the strips labeled 2 and 4 about ½" shy of the middle of the pie. Lay a strip horizontally across the middle of the pie, perpendicular to the other strips and going over strips 1, 3, and 5.
- C Then unfold strips 2 and 4. These will now be on top of the horizontal strip.
- d Fold strips 1, 3, and 5 back over the horizontal strip. Lay a second horizontal strip parallel to the first one. Unfold the folded strips.
- **C** This time fold strips 2 and 4 back over the second horizontal strip. Lay a third horizontal strip in place. Unfold strips 2 and 4.
- f Continue until there's no more room for horizontal strips. Turn the pie around and repeat the above steps to cover the other half of the pie. Trim excess dough from the strips; fold the extra ½" from the bottom crust up and over the ends of the strips. Crimp together.

Refer back to the full recipe directions in TQL to "embellish" and bake the pie. Enjoy! TQL
