Learn to create a small wallhanging of a lush bouquet of flowers and leaves arranged in a vase. By pre-cutting flowers and leaves before class, most of the hard work is done. The appliqué and quilting will be completed in one step and you will leave class with a mostly-finished piece ready to bind. Relax and have fun as you design and create a bouquet that reflects your own unique style!

**Supplies:**

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Cotton thread that blends with the backing fabric
- .004 wt. of clear monofilament polyester thread – stitching the flowers and leaves (Kevin recommends clear polyester monofilament thread)
- 40 wt. **OR** 50 wt. of cotton thread to match the background – quilting around the bouquet
- 40 wt. **OR** 50 wt. of cotton thread – quilting the “table” fabric
- (2-5) Sheets of 8.5" x 11" plain paper and a pencil – vase pattern
- 8.5" x 11" Sheet of fusible – fusing the vase to the background if desired (Optionally, you could bring freezer paper to make a pattern and turn the vase edges under for appliqué by either hand **OR** machine. Please bring a Goddess Sheet or similar if you plan to fuse.)
- Embroidery **OR** sharp point scissors – cutting out flowers/leaves in class
- (2) Good and fresh glue sticks; Roxanne’s Glue Baste It **OR** a glue pen are also good options (Test glue stick on fabric before coming to class to be sure it will hold fabrics together)
- Safety Pins, thread, **OR** Spray Baste – basting layers together (Sulky KK2000 **OR** a similar temporary adhesive is recommended. Do not use brands of spray baste that must be laundered away.)
- (1) Stiletto **OR** Purple Thang tool – holding down delicate petals and leaves as you stitch
- Fabric (Details in link below)

**Optional:** A pair of curved handled tweezers for arranging small pieces.
