Create a bug's eye view of nature with confetti cut fabrics "painted" on quilt backing. Layers and layers of tiny bits of batiks, hand-dyed, silk, and solid fabrics create this quilt. Fussy-cut tree trunks and branches are added before topping with a layer of tulle. Quilting threads embellish the art quilt with free-motion stitching. You can bring a photo to work from or borrow one from Sally.

Supplies:

A kit fee is required and includes: Tulle, specialty fibers, Angelina fibers, and specialty yarns.

Kit Fee: \$5 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- 26" x 26" of backing fabric
- 26" x 26" of batting (low loft such as, Warm & Natural)
- 24" x 24" of Hand dyed, batik **OR** sky print sky background
- (3-5) 2" x 18" Assorted black, brown, gray batik **OR** prints tree trunks
- (2-4) Each of 9" X 9" batik **OR** hand-dyed (not prints) each of yellow, gold, orange, and red fabric **OR** scraps leaves
- Flat box to take project home (Dollary Tree \$1 cardboard project board works well)
- (4-8) Snack-sized Ziploc® bags
