Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- Notebook, pen, and pencil
- Fabric (Details in link below)
- Fabric paint
- Variety of textured found objects – patterning
- Plastic **OR** eco-friendly spoons – get paint out of the jars (depending on how your paints are packaged)
- Brushes
- 4" Foam paint roller
- (1) Palette – put paint in
- Recycled yogurt **OR** sour cream container – hold rinse water for your paint brushes
- Spray bottle – hold water
- Small bucket **OR** tray – carrying your tools to the utility sink for rinsing
- A few inexpensive large size garbage bags to lay under your fabrics while they air dry
