Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: (2) basted quilt sandwiches made with white and black fabric and Quilter's Dream batting ($18" \times 22"$), plus (8) ($3" \times 18"$) solid-colored fabrics.

Kit Fee: \$35 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- A fresh new glue stick to adhere fabric
- Threads: at least (10) different spools of 50 wt. and/OR 40 wt. threads that are cotton OR polyester in solid colors. You can bring up to (20) spools.
- Fabric scissors
- Notebook, pen, and pencil
- Seam ripper

Optional: A square ruler at least 3" square and anywhere up to 6½" square
