In this technique workshop, you will learn how to piece the substrate so the wedges are varied in length, different ways to cut the wedges, and how to piece the wedges together into circles. Marge will also go over layouts and how to work with the circle blocks. Learn the technique, make three to four blocks, and learn the options for combining the blocks.
