Learn the basics of quilting with templates in a fun-filled workshop taught by Sew Steady Promoted Instructor Kate Quinn. This workshop is designed for the beginner with little to no experience with free-motion or ruler quilting. Learn how to set up your machine, needles, threads, proper hand positions, how to move the quilt sandwich, and some simple designs to get started. Designs include curved cross-hatching, straight line designs, spinning templates, echo quilting, and stitch in the ditch. Important tips and tricks to success are incorporated throughout the class material so you can explore the far-reaching potential rulers will bring to your quilting! This workshop is technique-oriented and templates may vary.

Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- (2) Fat quarter (18" x 22") quilt sandwiches in black OR dark grey (please use the same plain fabric for both the top and the backing; basting is not required. No puffy batting)
- (1) Rotary ruler such as a 3" x 12 OR 8" x 14" marking during class
- Thread snips
- Chair height may affect performance, so a seat cushion is highly recommended!

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
