#16W3500 – Appliqué

You'll breeze through hand appliqué when you trace, baste, snip and stitch the Eye of the Beholder way. In Margaret's method, you mark on the back and appliqué on the front. Your pieces will be precisely placed and basted for appliquéing down. But where to begin? Working together, you'll learn how to think it through step-by-step, layer by layer, from background to foreground as you patiently build and stitch the Cape Cod Knock-About block. Plus, explore other blocks for learning opportunities. The Cape Cod Knock-About block is excerpted from Margaret's newest wall-hanging, Ships Ahoy. Her method makes it pleasurable to stitch by hand and so, sew simple to get graceful curves and crisp points, inside and out. Join the fun!

Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- **[Basic Sewing Supplies](#)**
- (1) 13½" x 13½" Light blue background fabric
- (1) Fat quarter (18" x 22") of white fabric for sails
- (1) Fat eighth (9" x 22") of medium blue/turquoise print for water
- (1) Fat eighth (9" x 22") dark blue/teal fabric for boat hull
- (1) Fat eighth (9" x 22") black fabric for boat masts and booms
- (1) 3" x 3" square Bright medium blue fabric for burgee
- Fabric scissors (recommend our Kai 4" bent-handled, slightly blunt-tipped scissors)
- (5-10) safety pins, appliqué or straight pins
- Frixion gel pen or mechanical pencil for tracing the pattern onto the wrong side of the background fabric
- Beam N' Read personal light
- Desktop needle threader
- Lightbox strongly recommended (If no lightbox, scotch tape for taping to window)
