A kit is required and includes: (3) fat quarters (18" x 22") of solid fabric, (3) fat quarters (18" x 22") of print fabric, (3) fat quarters (18" x 22") of batting, thread (cotton, polyester, rayon) in various weights, written instructions, and the use of tools and materials for you to try in class that include a variety of threads, marking tools, grip aids, and more!

- Light fabric marker **OR** white chalk (your favorite)
- Notebook, pen, and pencil
