A kit is required and includes: (3) fat quarters ($18" \times 22"$) of solid fabric, (3) fat quarters ($18" \times 22"$) of print fabric, (3) fat quarters ($18" \times 22"$) of batting, thread (cotton, polyester, rayon) in various weights, written instructions, and the use of tools and materials for you to try in class that include a variety of threads, marking tools, grip aids, and more!

- Thread snips **OR** scissors
- Light fabric marker **OR** white chalk (your favorite)
- Notebook, pen, and pencil
