Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- ½ yd. of fabric fronts & backs of samples **OR** at least (20) scraps cut into (20) 4½" x 5½" pieces (please precut fabric before class)
- Thin, sturdy batting cut into (10) 4½" x 5½" pieces (Warm & Natural cotton batting is recommended)
- ¼ yd. of fabric binding
- 1/8 yd. of fusible web like Wonder Under **OR** Heat N Bond Lite
- ½ vd. of 1" wide ribbon
- ½ 1 yd. of yarn for couching
- Seed beads OR small bugle beads
- Beading needle
- Beading thread
- An assortment of machine threads (Suggestions: rayon, quilting, variegated, metallic)
- Chenille and embroidery hand sewing needles
