Learn the ins and outs of how to set up your machine for FMQ, how to balance stitch tension for FMQ, and how to find YOUR perfect rhythm and speed – a fool-proof technique to get a perfect stitch length every time. Learn to use simple patterns that look great, the fundamental shapes that can build into any pattern, and form an easy technique for setting a zipper. By the end of class, you will know how to create three different case shapes from one simple block.
