In simplest terms, a medallion quilt is made of a central motif surrounded by multiple borders. The center and borders could be pieced, appliquéd, or embroidered, in any number of combinations. Using Electric Quilt, designing a medallion style quilt has hundreds of options, from complicated appliquéd or piecing, to simplified border designs.
