Please bring the following items to class:

• Basic Sewing Supplies

For the Carnation block, you will need:

• (1) fat guarter (18" x 22") of background fabric

Scraps of fabric for the flowers, leaves and stems -- they should be at least fat eighths (9" \times 22") in size.

- (3) greens for stems and leaves
- (2) fabrics for carnations
- (4) fabrics for center flower
- (1) 18" square of Shape Flex 101 (SF101)
- Empty bobbins will be supplied to match your top thread
