Beautiful wool appliqué is easily achieved with a few simple steps. Learn how to use your sewing machine to create a small sample that can be turned into a pillow, a pin cushion, a zipper bag, or a small crossbody bag. Choose from the variety of decorative stitches to make your wool appliqué a unique piece. We'll use designer-weight threads to add texture and sheen.

Supplies:

A material fee is required and includes: a pattern for the project, fusible web, and other supplies brought by the instructor

Material Fee: \$15 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) 12½" square of cotton background fabric
- Scraps or small pieces of a variety of colors of felted wool (some of the pieces need to be 4" x 6" in size, as you may want to use the fabric for several parts of the design).
- Threads to match the colors of your wool (Annie prefers either Aurifil 28-weight cotton threads **OR** Sulky 12-weight cotton threads.)
- Small handwork scissors (Annie likes the Elan E6 scissors, available on her website.)

Optional:

An optional kit is available and includes: a pattern, background fabric, all wool fabrics for the project, threads to match the fabrics, fusible web, a pencil, and other nice little notions that will come in handy. If you opt for this optional kit, you don't have to pay the materials fee - it's included in this kit. There will be optional threads for sale at the workshop, which are not usually found in quilt shops. **\$42**
