This is a modern traditional quilt that combines the traditional piecing methods of Studio 180 Design and the curved piecing methods from Sew Kind of Wonderful. This design utilizes the Tucker Trimmer I[™] tool from Studio 180 Design and the Wonder Curve[™] from Sew Kind of Wonderful. In class you will master the use of both specialized tools and learn many tips and tricks for curved and precision piecing.

Pattern Fee: \$10 (preorder or purchase in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Fabric requirements:
 - 2 yd. of fabric 1 – borders, binding, center and corner blooms
 - 5/8 yd. of fabric 2 – center, corner and inner chain blooms
 - 3/4 yd. of fabric 3 – float blooms
 - 3/8 yd. of fabric 4 – float blooms
 - 1 1/4 yd. of fabric 5 – center, corner, inner and outer chain blooms
 - 1/2 yd. of fabric 6 – inner and outer chain blooms
 - 1/4 yd. of fabric 7 – inner and outer chain blooms
 - 3 1/4 yd. of background fabric
- Specialty Tool: Tucker Trimmer I[™] by Studio 180 Design
- Wonder Curve© by Sew Kind of Wonderful
- 6" x 12" ruler **OR** equivalent
- Tweezers

Optional: Invisigrip – a non-slip film for the backside of tools, strip stick – aides in pressing seams open, pressing block – aides in flat seam, and camera
