Double-points put a contemporary spin on this long-time favorite and they eliminate the need of a traditional appliquéd circle in the center! Using quarter circles, half circles, and three-quarter circles adds another interesting bit of character. Learn Susan's tips for turning wedge points with the Prairie Pointer Tool and use tricky piecing to assemble the arcs, circle, and background. Points are three dimensional and design possibilities are endless! Finished quilt is 27"x 24".

Supplies:

A pattern is required for class.

Pattern Fee: \$9 or Book Fee: \$25 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Background fabrics: Fat quarters or 1/4yd cuts of 4-9 different fabrics, 2 of those fabrics need to be over 18.5" in length. Starch before cutting.
- Dresden fabrics: at least (8) 4.5"x18" strips OR equivalent (may be all same or all different) Starch before cutting.
- ½ yd. of white cotton fabric, heavily starched (will not show in finished quilt) foundation fabric
- 50 wt. **OR** 60 wt. (regular weight) cotton thread piecing and bobbin in color to coordinate with background fabric and colors to coordinate with Dresden fabrics
- 18 degree and/or 30 degree wedge ruler (or purchase in class \$13 and \$16)
- Optional Prairie Pointer Tool (\$24) and Dynamic Dresden's Rulers (\$13-\$16) will be available for purchase in class.
