Please bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- (8) 18" x 22" fat quarters (solids) in eight different colors that create a transition from one color to another (for example from purple to red) **OR** (7) 18" x 22" fat quarters that are in the same color going from a lighter shade to a darker shade
- Piece of Cotton batting that measures 30" x 40"
- Painters tape
