A kit is required and includes: full color handout to complete the quilt, foundation paper that stays in the quilt, custom acrylic templates, and a re-useable foundation piecing stencil.

- (24) 3" x 4" rectangles B&W dots
- (4) 4½" squares of Hot Pink
- (20) 2½" x 3½" rectangles Orange
- (4) 2½" x 8½" strip of Lime Green
- (1) 2½" x 8½" strip of Orange
- (12) 2½" x 8½" strips of B&W dots
- Pigma Brush or Chisel tip pen (available for purchase in class is \$4)
- (1) sheet of template plastic **OR** tracing paper/Vellum
- Square ruler with diagonal line (Linda uses a 9½" square)
- Fabric pre-cut and bagged
