- [Basic Sewing Supplies](#)
- (1) 18" x 22" fat quarter of your background fabric (solid or prints)
- (4) 10" squares of fabric (different colors) - these squares will be your organic shapes, can be solids or prints
- Scissors with a fine point for cutting fabrics
- Washable glue with a fine point applicator (could be a Helmer's glue or Roxane glue for basting)
- Fabric marker (erasable)
