- ¼ yd. pink batik fabrics
- ½ yd. purple/pink multi batik fabrics
- 11/4 yd. turquoise batik fabrics
- 1/3 yd. pink/purple multi batik fabrics
- ½ yd. blue/pink/purple batik fabrics
- ½ yd. dark pink batik fabrics
- 1¼ yd. dark purple batik fabrics
- 55% yd. light background batik fabrics
- Cactus in Bloom Pattern for class
- Foundation Paper (Carol Doak's)
- One piece of template plastic (3" x 12")
- 12" Add-a-Ouarter ruler
- 6" x 12" rectangular ruler
- 8" square ruler
- Eyebrow trimmer shaper
