Starting with two Fat Quarters and various interfacing, students will build their hat from scratch and walk away in style with their new one of a kind hat. This workshop mixes quilting and clothing construction to help students build their skill set and branch out to new things. A printed pattern with templates is also available.

A kit is required and includes: (1) 8" x 6.5" Fusible Ultra-Firm Stabilizer, (1) 10" x 10" Fusible Foam Stabilizer, (1) 9" x 20" Interfacing, (1) 3" x 8" Interfacing, (1) 3" x 5/8" Velcro Fastener, (1) Wooden chopstick

Please bring the following items to class:

- (2) Fat Quarters (18" x 22"), one for the outside of the hat and one for the lining.
- A 10" x 10" piece of fabric for the front panel, this can be complimentary fabric or even an orphan quilt block
- Matching or contrasting thread of your choice that will be visible on the finished hat.
