After the stitchwork of a Mola is complete, interest is added by the Kuna makers with some very finely worked basic embroidery stitches. The running stitch, seed stitch, chain stitch, feather stitch, fly stitch, and buttonhole to name a few. They are worked in threads or floss. Come learn these basic stitches and how they are used so you can embellish your Molas/ favorite quilt pieces with embroidery with a modern twist.

**A kit is required and includes:** (1) 16" x 16" white batik/muslin, (1) Embroidery needle, **Spring Mola Mug Rug** pattern, use of Hand Embroidery threads, hand-outs: 6 page- How-To of Basic Embroidery Stitches; 2 page- List of Helpful Tutorials & Blogs; Eye of the Beholder toe bag. **Supplies:**

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- (1) 12" x 12" white batik/muslin
- Frixion gel pen **OR** mechanical pencil for tracing pattern lines onto fabric
- Lightbox
- Small embroidery hoop (7" – 9")
- Kai slightly blunt-tipped scissors recommended (either bent-handled or straight)

Optional:

- Beam N' Read personal light
- Note: Embroidery threads will be available to stitch with, but you may want to bring some thread types or colors to play with for embroidery.
- If you have a completed mola they would like to add embroidery to they should bring it to class.

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
