Double points put a contemporary spin on this long-time favorite and eliminate the need for an appliquéd circle in the center. This allows rings to interlock! These Dresdens are built on a foundation so background fabrics don't shadow through and, more importantly, Dresdens turn out perfectly flat. Learn Susan's tips for speedily turning wedge points with the Prairie Pointer Tool. At home you can finish the quilt by quilting the background then ditch stitching Dresdens onto the quilted quilt! Design possibilities are endless!

Please bring the following items to class:

- Starch, press, THEN cut at least (4) 5.5" strips at least 18" in length (or the equivalent) for one Dresden ring (may be many fabrics or just one)
- Thread snips, approximate 12" ruler for drawing lines, 18- or 30-degree Dynamic Dresdens wedge ruler (available for purchase in class \$14 \$17) OR a different 18- or 30-degree ruler might work

Optional:

An optional kit is available and includes: Prairie Pointer Tool for turning Dresden points (no pre-order is necessary) \$24.
