### Block Nineteen: Santa's Log Cabin

Finished Block Size: 8½" x 8½" Unfinished Block Size: 9" x 9"

#### Cutting Instructions

To create a scrappy look, use different fabrics in the same group. The light group uses three fabrics, and the dark group uses two fabrics.

From the light fabrics, cut:

(3) 2" strips

From the light strip you want to use by the center, cut:

(1) 2" square

From the dark fabrics, cut:

(2) 2" strips

From the center print, fussy cut:

(1) 2" square


## Piecing Instructions

1. Sew the print fussy cut 2" square to the side of the light 2" square. Press.




Unit measures 3½" x 2" rectangle.

2. Sew a light 2" strip from the same fabric used in the previous step, along the lower edge of the previous unit. Trim off any extra from the light strip. Press.




Unit now measures 3½" x 3½" square.

3. Sew a dark 2" strip along the right side of the previous unit. Trim off the extra from the dark strip and sew it to the top of the unit. Trim off any extra from the dark strip. Press.




Unit now measures 5" x 5" square.

4. Sew the next light 2" strip along the left side of the previous unit. Trim off the extra from the light strip and sew it to the bottom of the unit. Trim off any extra from the light strip. Press.




Unit now measures 6½" x 6½" square.

5. Sew the next dark 2" strip along the right side of the previous unit. Trim off the extra from the dark strip and sew it to the top of the unit. Trim off any extra from the dark strip. Press.



Unit now measures 8" x 8" square.

6. Sew the final light 2" strip along the left side of the previous unit. Trim off the extra from the light strip and sew it to the bottom of the unit. Trim off any extra from the light strip. Press.



Unit now measures  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

7. Trim block evenly on all sides to measure 9" x 9" unfinished.
