### Block Two: Cross and Crown

Finished Block Size: 8 ½" x 8 ½"

#### Cutting Instructions

From the background fabric, cut:

- (4) 2¼" x 2¼" squares, label A.
- (2) 3" x 3" squares, cut on both diagonals for a total of 8 triangles, label B.
- (4) 2" x 4" rectangles, label C.

From the light triangle fabric, cut:

- (2) 4½" x 4½" squares, cut once diagonally for a total of 4 triangles, label D.

From the print fabric, cut:


- (2) 3" x 3" squares, cut on both diagonals for a total of 8 triangles, label B.

From the center square fabric, cut:

- (1) 2" x 2" square, label E.


## Unit Assembly

1. Sew one background fabric B triangle to one print fabric B triangle on the short edges as shown below. Press to the darker fabric.




Make 4 B/B left units and 4 B/B right units.

2. Sew the completed triangle units to each side of a background fabric A square as shown below. Press.




Make four A/B units.

3. Line up an A/B unit with a light fabric D triangle, matching the corners. Sew down the long side as shown below to complete the corner.



Trim unit to measure 4" square. Make four Corner units.

4. Sew a Corner unit to each side of a background fabric C rectangle as shown below.




The row measures 9" x 4" rectangle. Make two.

5. Sew a background fabric C rectangle to each side of a center fabric E square as shown below.



The center row measures 9" x 2" rectangle.

6. Sew the rows together as shown below to complete the block. Be sure all the large triangles are pointing inward toward the center square.



The block measures 9" x 9" square.
