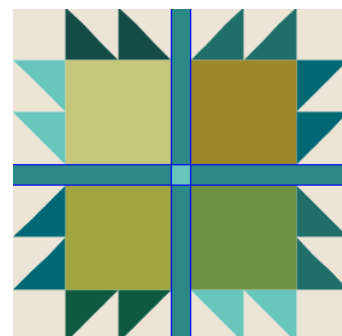


Bear Paw Workshop : A Fork in the Woods

The Bear Paw units take on a life of their own during the construction process. Changes in color placement, rotation of a unit, addition of sashing and corner stones all impact the final look and feel of the quilt. This week of your journey is the week to assess layout plans and catch up on Paw construction.

The Path Chosen

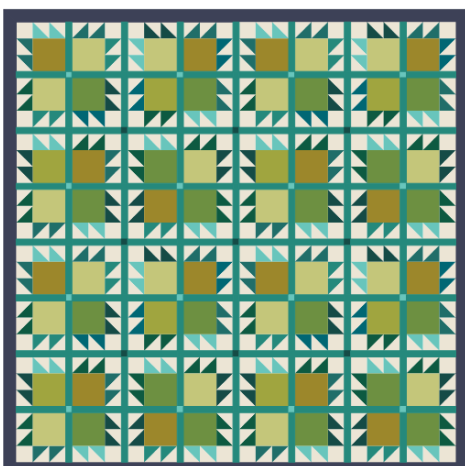
- Revisit the layout options. Remember each is basically a “swatch” of the finished quilt.
- Layout your completed Paw units to evaluate and confirm you are still on the “correct” layout path.
 - If you are opting to change direction, this is the week to stitch up any additional Paws needed for the “new” layout.
 - If your layout will feature sashing, double sashing or cornerstones as in the Classic Layout, audition fabric options and make your selection this week.



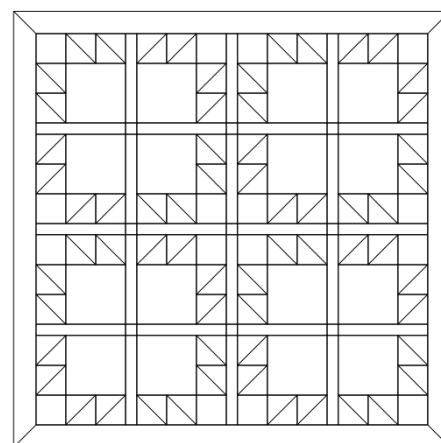

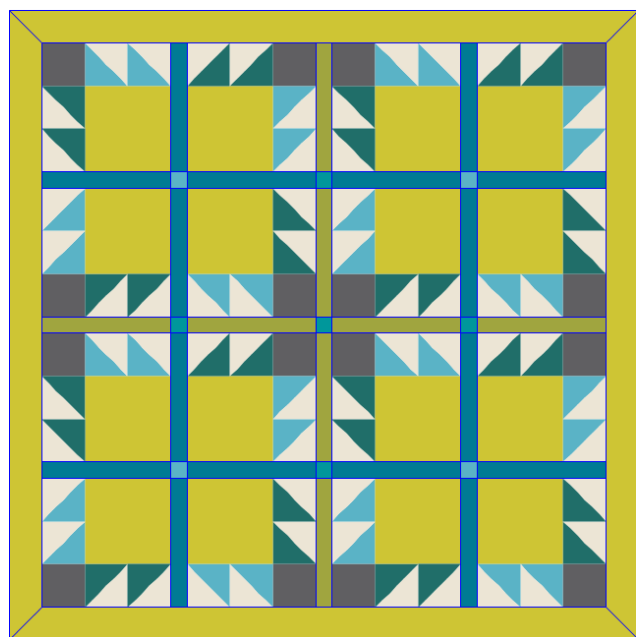
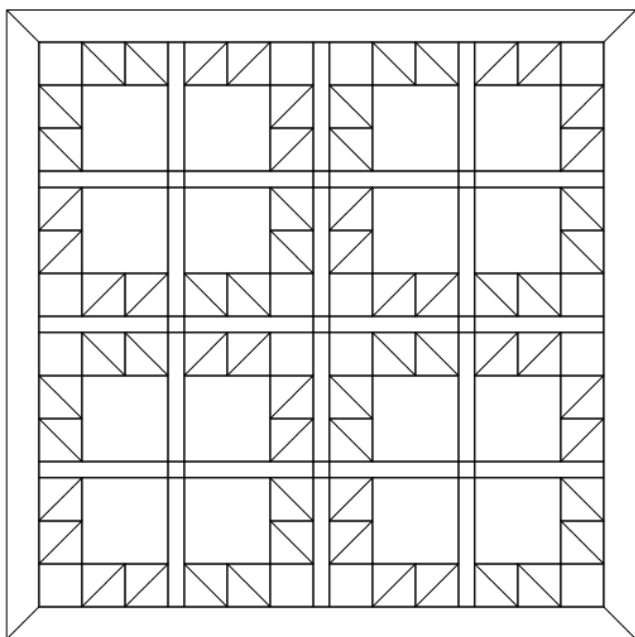
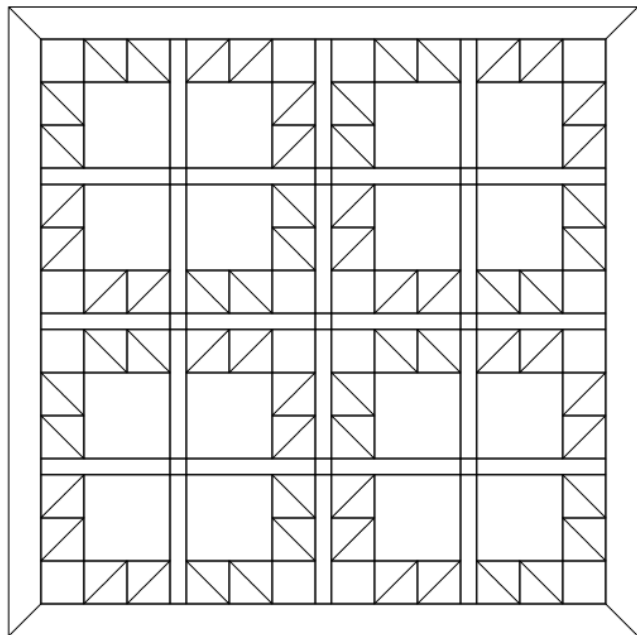
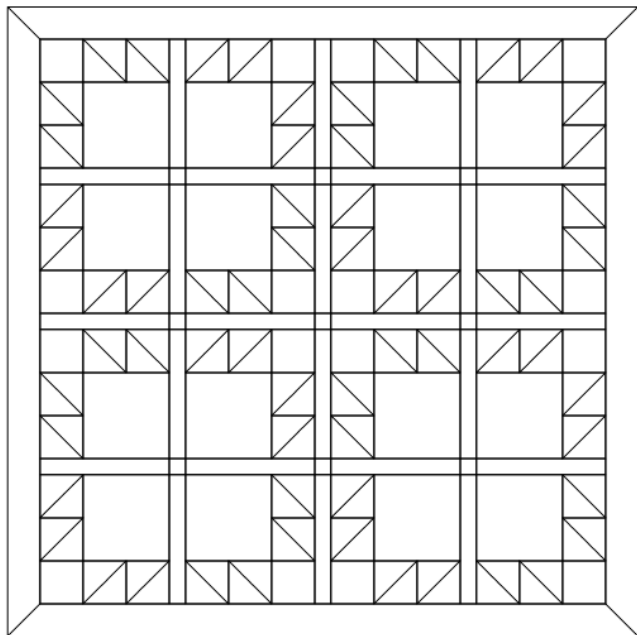


Classic Layout



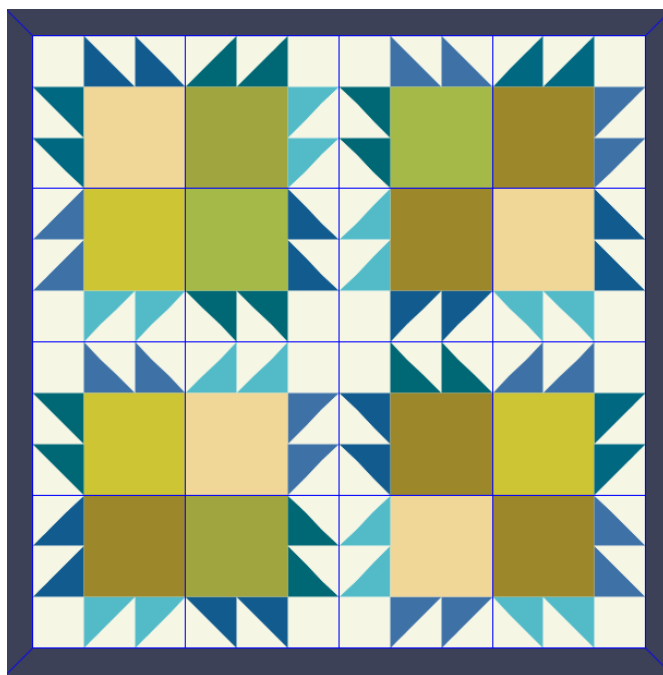
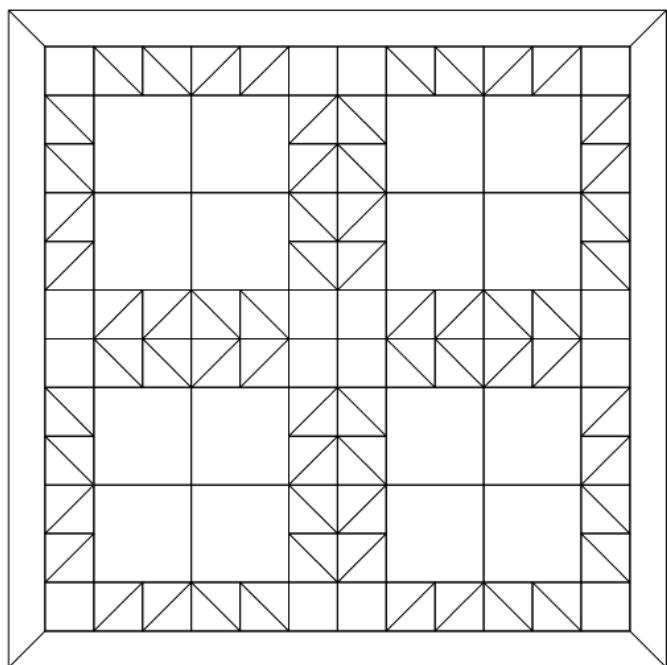
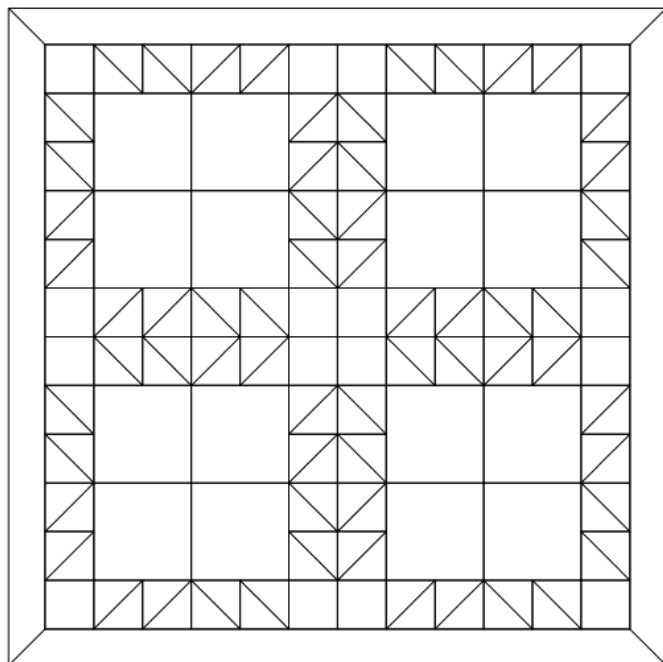
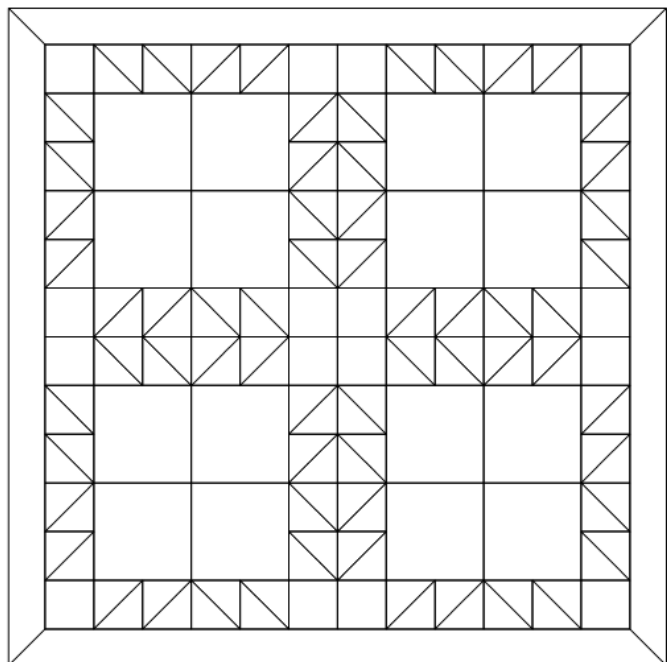
Swatch: For color and planning. Each Paw finishes 6”; the swatch pictured represents approximately 30” with sashing not including the borders.





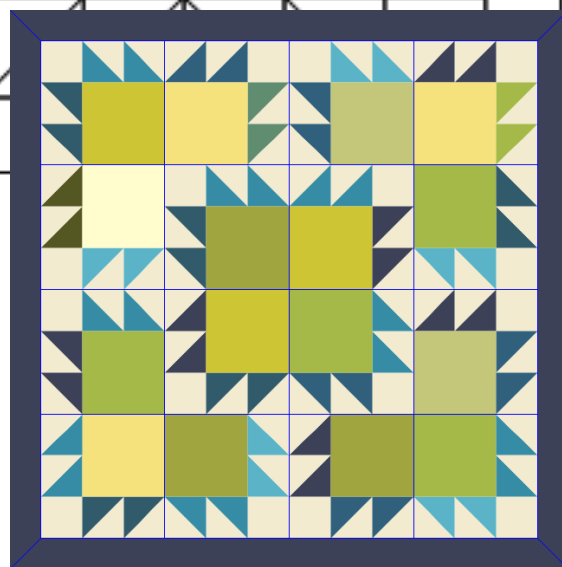
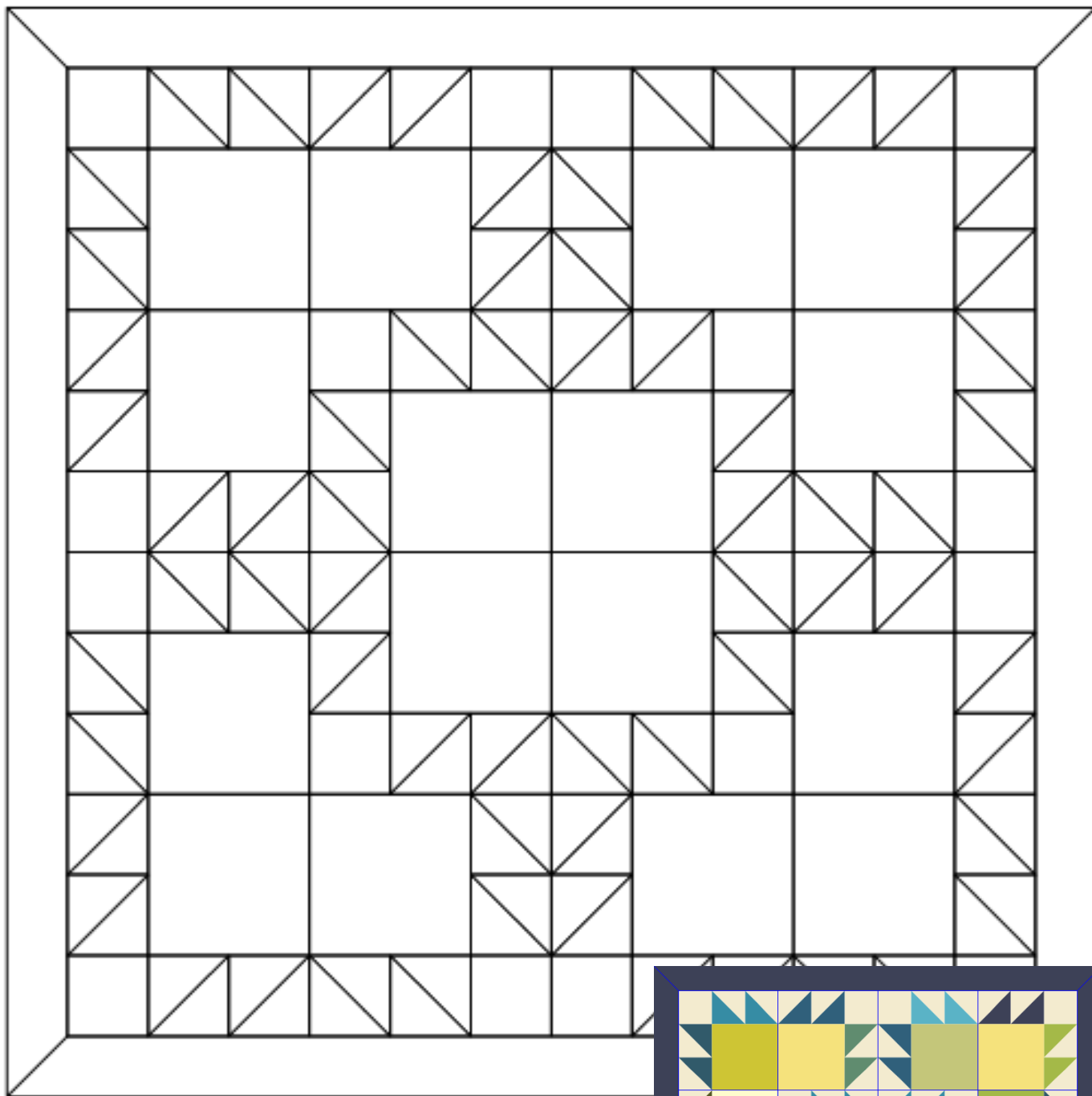
Coloring page: Classic Layout "swatch"
4 Full Blocks/16 Bear Paw Units





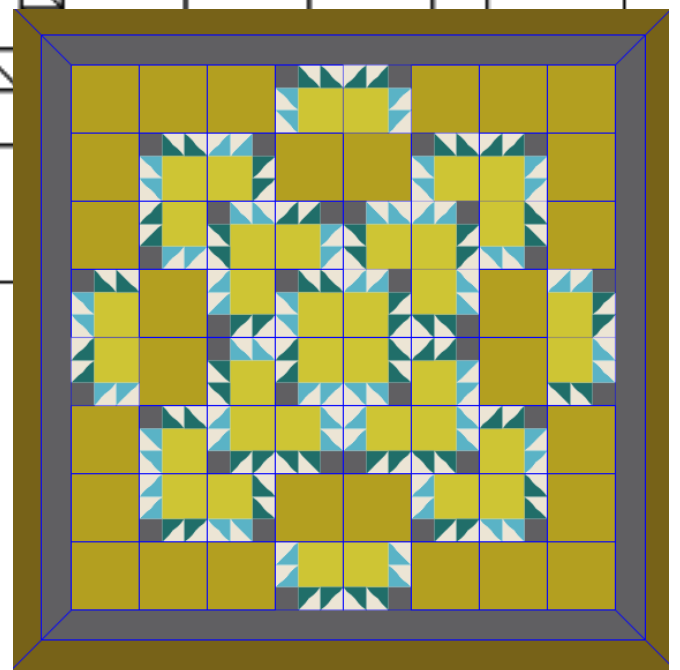
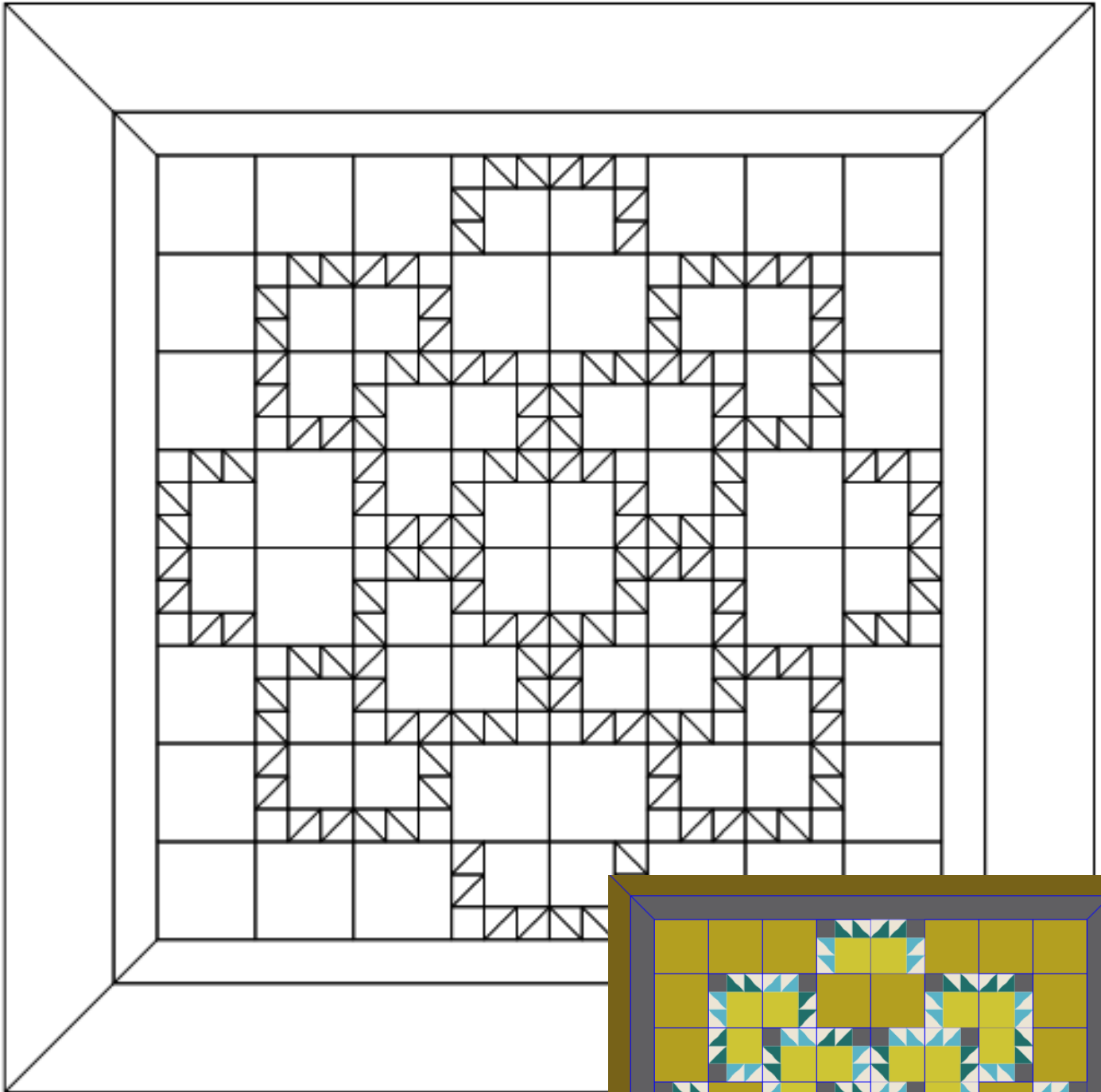
Coloring page: Classic Layout "swatch"/ no sashing
4 Full Blocks/16 Bear Paw Units





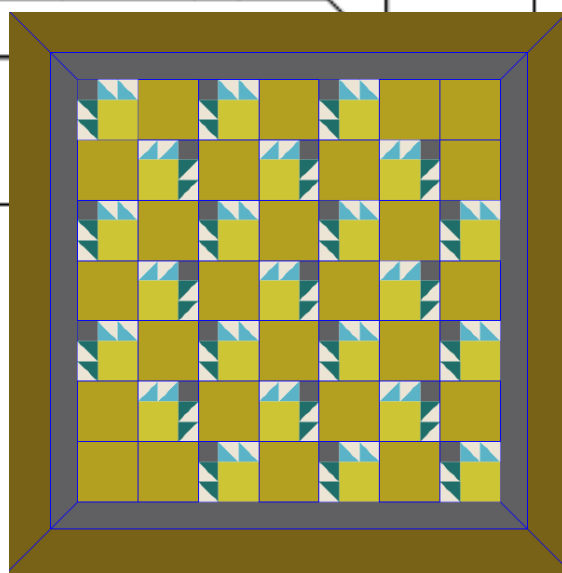
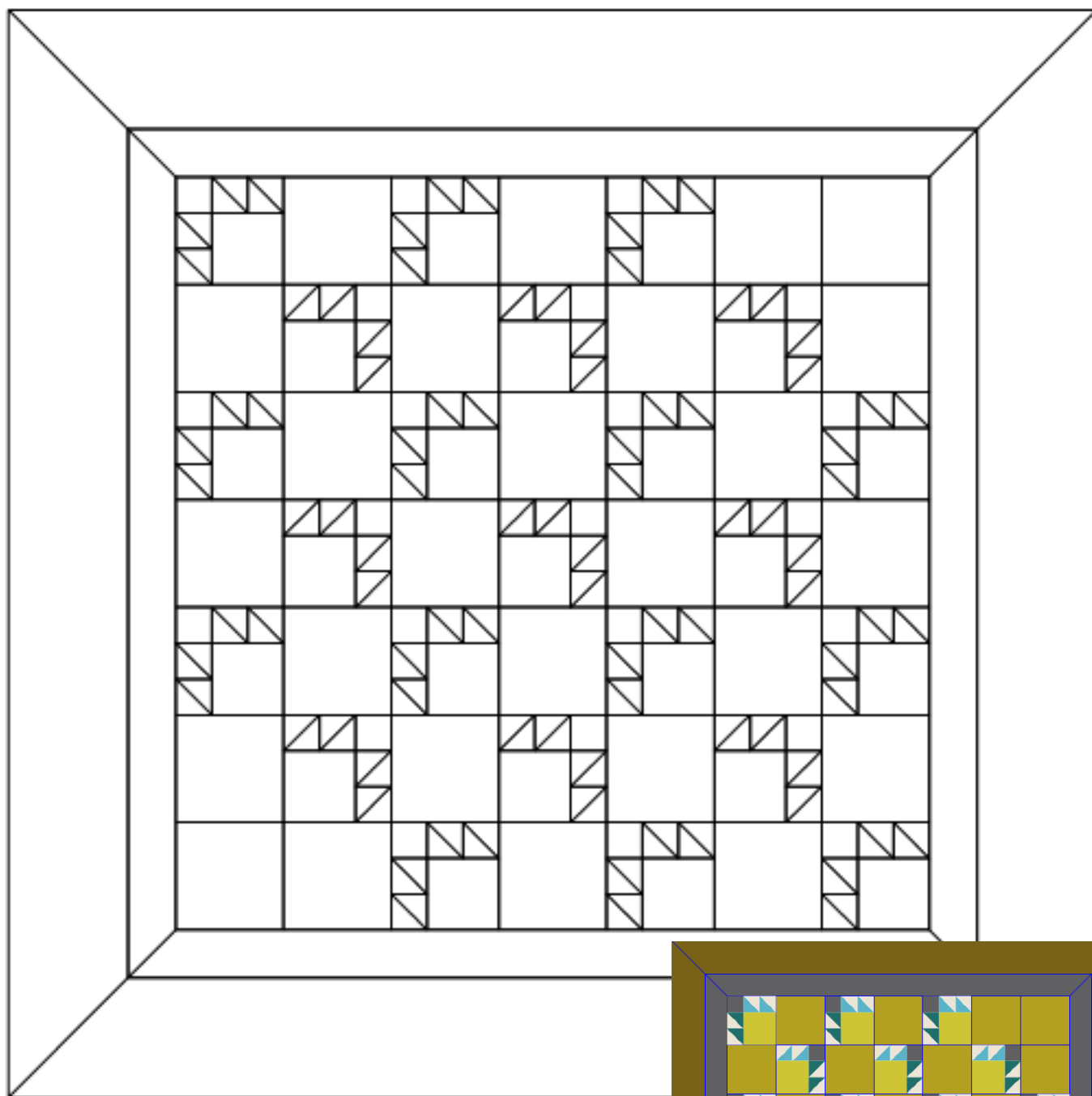
Coloring page: Make a Splash

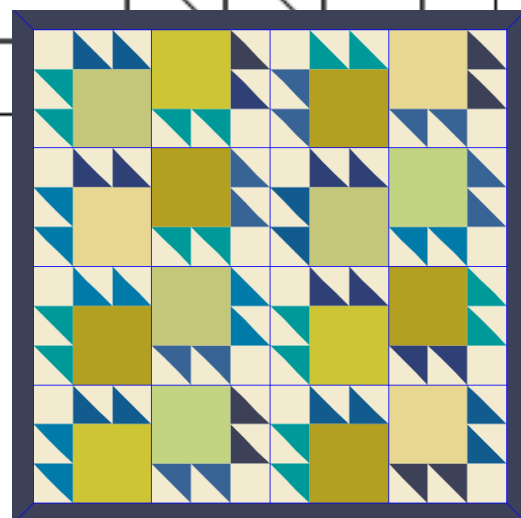
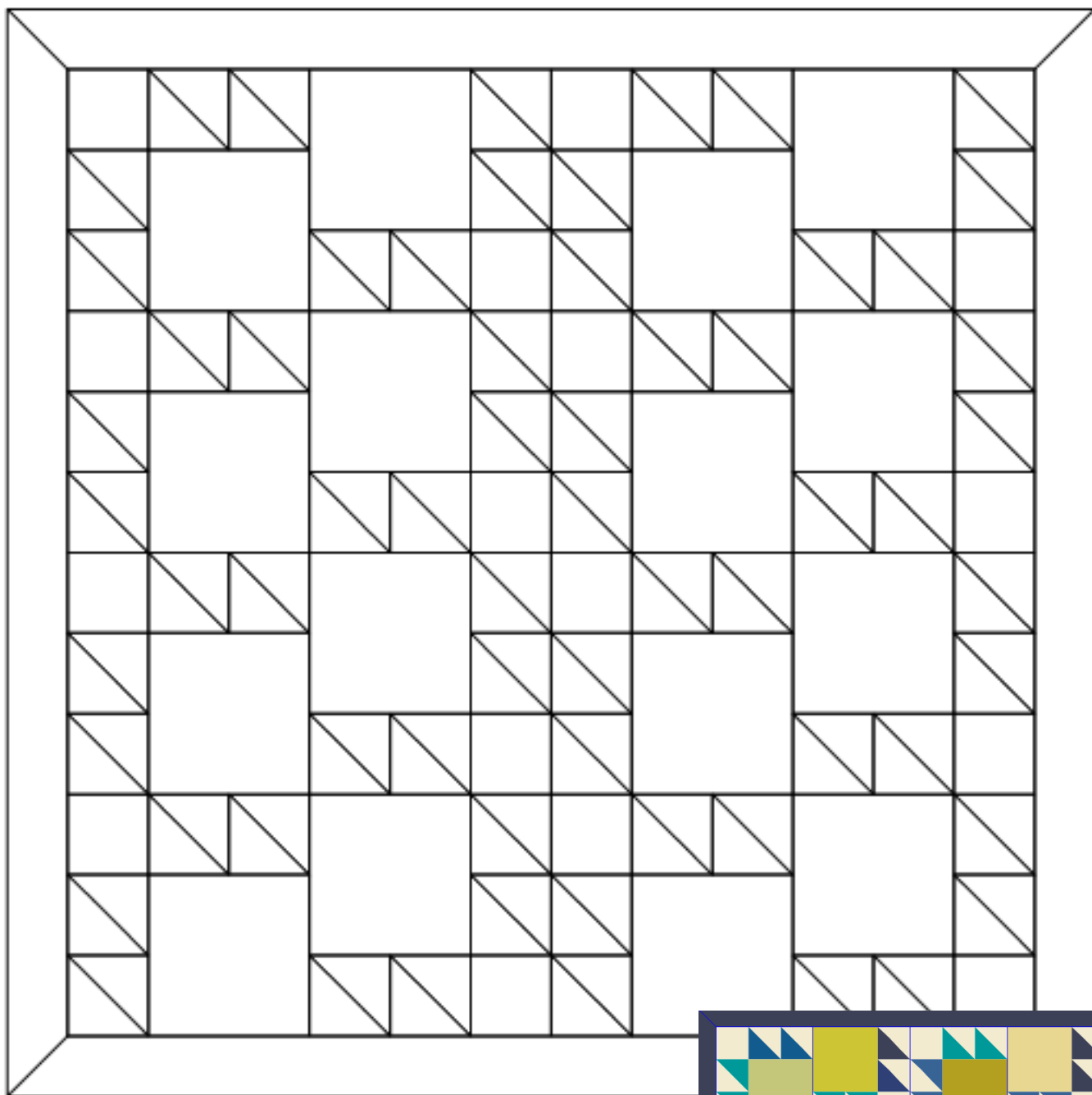
Coloring page: Waves
