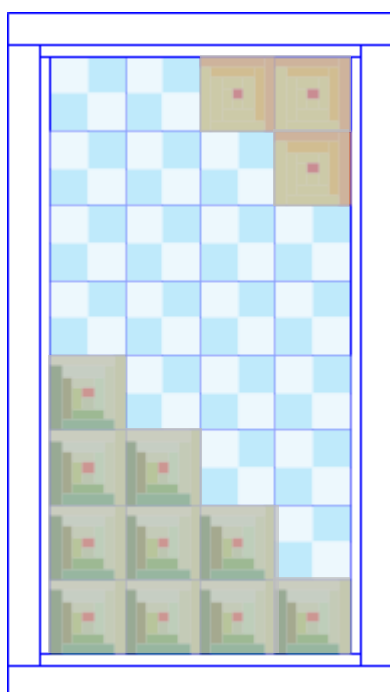
Techniques Featured:

- *Twirled Seams*

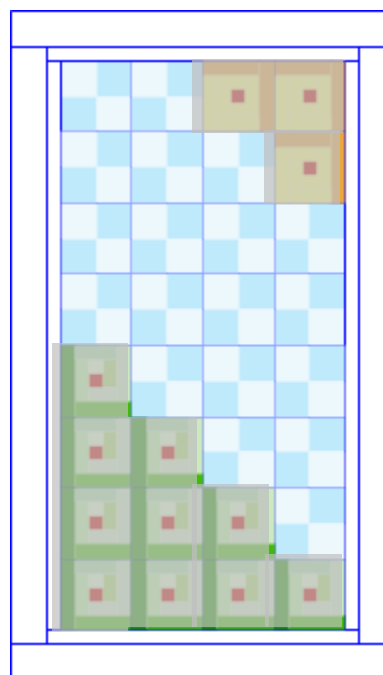
Pro Tips

- *Read through all instructions before beginning.*
- *Seam Allowance= 1/4"*

Instructions included for 2 sizes.



Size A: 28" x 56"
7" finished blocks



Size B: 20" x 40"
5" finished blocks



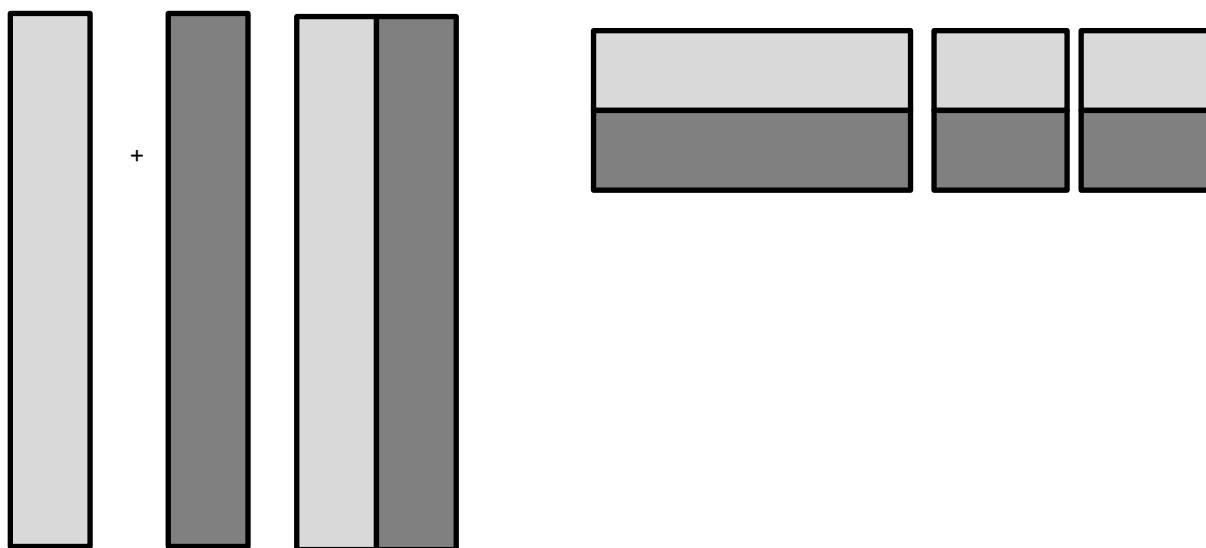
Four Patch Block

Strip Sets

Using the two background fabrics, cut strips according to the chart below.

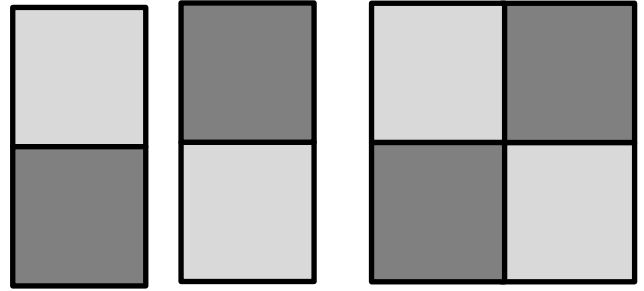
<u>Size A (Large)</u>		<u>Size B (Small)</u>	
Fabric (1)	Cut 4 strips 4 inch x WOF	Fabric (1)	Cut 4 strips 3 inch x WOF
Fabric (2)	Cut 4 strips 4 inch x WOF	Fabric (2)	Cut 4 strips 3 inch x WOF
Sub-Cut	Into (38) 4 inch units	Sub-Cut	Into (38) 3 inch units

- Place Fabric (1) and Fabric (2) strips right sides together.
- Stitch together along length. Press toward the dark fabric (Fabric 2).

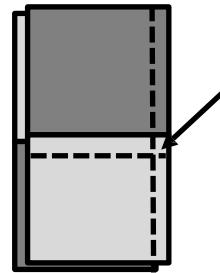


Quilt Along with QUILTERS SELECT®

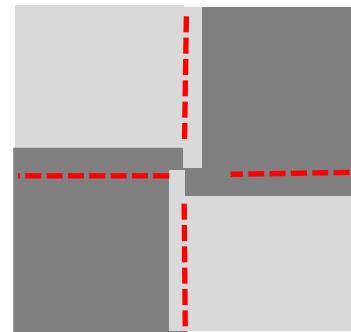
- Stitch units together in pairs to form 4-patch units, nesting the seams to keep the centers aligned.



- Carefully remove the stitches that cross the intersection of the seam allowance. Gently pull the seam allowance at center intersection open.



- Working from the wrong side of the unit, press the seam allowances toward the light fabric. The seam allowance at the center of the unit will open up resembling a small 4-patch unit.
- Using this method distributes the bulk to create a flat unit.



Press seam allowance to the light side.

Make (19) four-patch blocks

Large quilt units = $7\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$



Quilt Along with QUILTERS SELECT®

Small quilt units= 5 ½" x 5 ½"
