

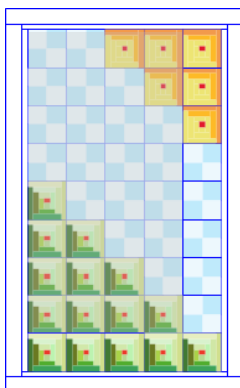
# Quilt Along with QUILTERS SELECT®

## Whirligig Garden Stitch Along – Week 4

Constructing the main portion of the quilt: sky, sun, and ground will allow for a break from all those fabric and design decisions. It's also a great opportunity to finish constructing any missing blocks.

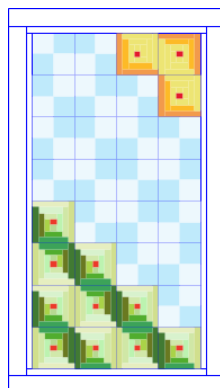
But first, I have a few burning questions: **What if.....**

- What if I want my quilt even bigger?
- What if I rotate or replace some blocks?
- How can I make my sky more interesting?



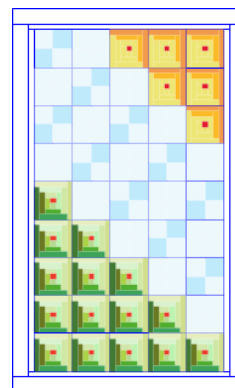
### **Bigger**

Add one more column to the right and one more row to the bottom



### **Rotate**

Turn every other block to see what happens



### **Replace**

Remove some 4-patch blocks and replace with simpler squares



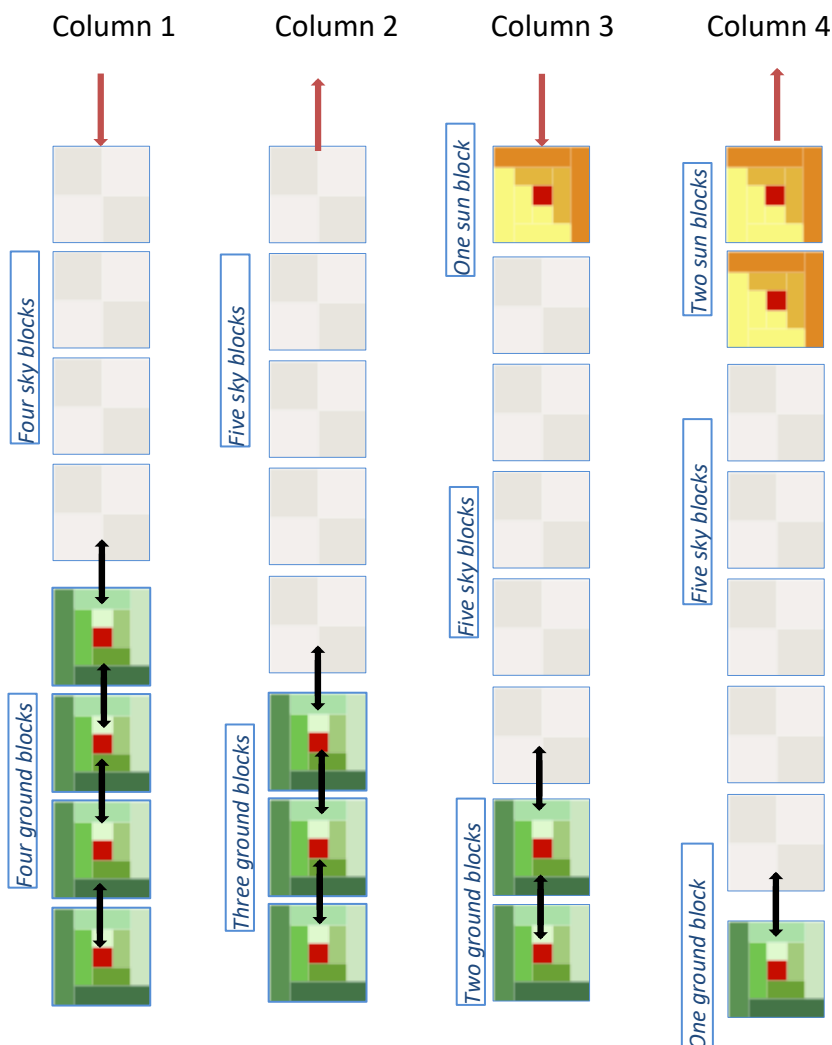
### **Sky**

Add a variety of lighter and darker fabrics

# Quilt Along with QUILTERS SELECT®

## Quilt Top Assembly

- Layout the units following the placement diagram to ensure each block is in the correct location and orientation.
- Sew into columns.
- Press the seams between the FPP log cabins and any adjoining blocks open as shown with the black arrows.
- Press the remaining seams in the odd numbered columns down and the even numbered columns up as shown with the red arrows.



## Pro Tips

- Nest seams wherever possible to create a crisp intersection
- It is not necessary to remove all/any of the foundation paper if using QS Print and Piece. The partially water-soluble fibers will dissolve leaving the quilt soft after washing.
- If using an alternative foundation, remove after all units are joined together.



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
