Sew Machine – Required

You're welcome to bring your machine, or sewing machines are available for rent at \$99 for the week, including two empty bobbins to get you started. Please note that rented machines must stay in the classrooms, and friendly on-site support will be available to assist you. Be sure to reserve your machine when you register, and no later than 60 days before the event. If you did not reserve a machine during registration but wish to do so, please contact a Registration Coordinator at 270-898-7903 by July 31, 2026.

Required Supplies

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- · Sewing Machine, foot pedal and all cords
- Bobbins have several prewound before class
- Extra sewing machine needles
- Pattern Be sure to bring the original. Copies are not allowed.
- Rotary Cutter 45mm and a 28mm (a new blade is a necessity!)
- Rulers for cutting fabric A small 2 ½" x 6", a 6 ½" x 12" and a 6 ½" x 24" (or 8 ½" x 24")
- Add a ¼" ruler if you feel you need one
- Piecing Thread Stacie prefers Aurifil in white and/or black, depending on your project
- Fabric Scissors Stacie prefers Karen Kay Buckley with the purple handles

- Scotch Tape

- Freezer Paper
- Seam Ripper
- Pen, Pencil and paper Fabric Pencil Stacie prefers Sewline White Chalk Pencil
- Fabric Glue Pen Stacie prefers Sewline (bring refills)
- Magic Pins I prefer the blue quilting pins or the Ultra Fine Glass Head Pins (Clover #2507)
- Paper-Creasing Tool a piece of cardstock or plastic template approx 2"x8" works well.
- Ziploc Baggies in Various Sizes
