BRANSON CONVENTION CENTER MAP








PARKING

Branson Convention Center Parking – A parking garage is attached to the Branson Convention Center and may be accessed via Sycamore Street. Prevailing rates will be charged for garage parking. A large, uncovered parking lot is available on the south side of the Convention Center. There is a \$7.00 per day charge for parking in this lot. You will also find limited, free street parking around the Branson Convention Center.

The Ties That Bind, curated by Wendy Brackman

In Fall of 2017, Wendy Brackman, an artist and quilter based in Arkville, New York, learned that the Pine Hill Community Center had received a large donation of silk men's ties. Inspired by the variety of color and beautiful patterns, Wendy started a community project to keep hands busy during the long winter months in the Catskill Mountains. During the long winter of 2018, a dozen dedicated quilters washed, opened, and ironed hundreds of men's ties for the purpose of cutting out hexagon shapes to create these mosaic story sculptures.

New Quilts From an Old Favorite: Wheel of Fortune, The National Quilt Museum

The New Quilts from an Old Favorite contest and exhibition was created by The National Quilt Museum to pay tribute to our quiltmaking heritage while celebrating the innovation, creativty, and excellence of today's quilter. This contest and exhibition challenges quilt artists to interpret a single traditional quilt block in a work of their original design.

The most recent contest required all quilt entries to be recognizable in some way as a variation on the selected 2020 traditional block, Wheel of Fortune. The quilts are no larger than 80" and no smaller than 50" on a side, and each entry was quilted and submitted by the artist(s).



SPECIAL EXHIBITS



Titanic Quilt

The idea for the TITANIC quilt originated from Deborah Hipple's interest in history and visits to exhibits recognizing the loss of the *Titanic*. After a multitude of research, she decided to feature the ship rather than the tragedy as she read accounts of the ordeal. Techniques used included abstract layering and raw-edge appliqué for the water, lacemaking for the railings, beading, coloring, top stitching, and free-motion quilting. Attention was paid to details including the correct number of windows to make the art quilt look realistic. The design on the back of the quilt is the iceberg against the night sky.



SAQA: Wide Horizons VII

The expression "wide horizons" often evokes feelings of openness, exploration, experimentation, new work, new themes, or new stories. But the words can also be interpreted as in-depth analysis of favorite subjects, seeing familiar things in a new light, and pushing the boundaries of what we already do. Whatever the approach chosen, creativity rather than mere technical skill and commitment to the art form should be foremost. Artists were encouraged to submit work likely to spark a conversation on some aspect of the theme. Quilters from ten European countries made the guilts in this exhibit.

The Diana Cherrywood Challenge Sponsored by



The challenge was to take inspiration from Diana, Princess of Wales, to create a unique quilt using a limited color palette: pink and white. Quilters were encouraged to push themselves creatively, think outside the box, and create new fiber art. The contest was open to anyone and everyone.

All the quilts are the same color, fabric, size and theme, making the exhibit very cohesive and striking. Cherrywood fabrics in the official challenge bundle had to be used; accent colors were allowed. Quilt size is 20" x 20". Any techniques or embellishments could be used.




