

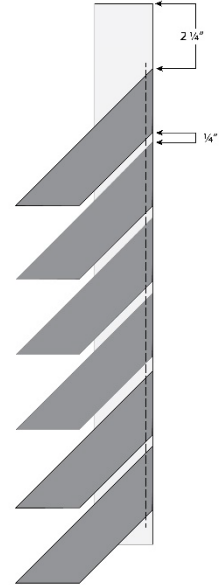


PATTERN CONSTRUCTION

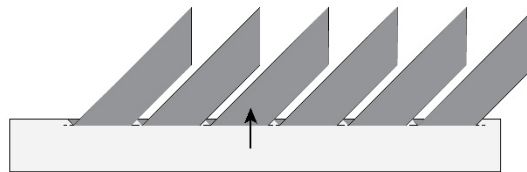
APPLYING STAR POINTS TO TRAPEZOIDS

4. **Gather** the (11) of the 2 1/4" Background Strips (Diamond) . **Sub cut** the (11) WOF Strips into (22) HWOFF Strips. Start with one of your Half Yard Fabric's trapezoids and position the Trapezoids right sides together with the "pointy" end of the Trapezoid pointed up, so it will be the first to go under the needle and align the edge of the Trapezoid with the edge of the right side of the strip. **Position** the first Trapezoid 2 1/4" down from the selvage of the strip.

5. **Stitch** the trapezoids to the strip using an accurate 1/4" seam allowance and a chain piecing style of sewing. **Leave** approximately 1/4" of space between the trapezoids. You should be able to **place** (6) "like" fabric Trapezoids on each of the HWOFF Background Strips.



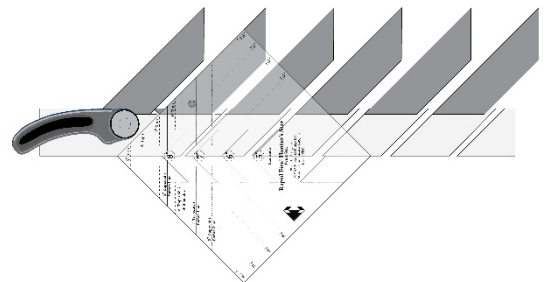
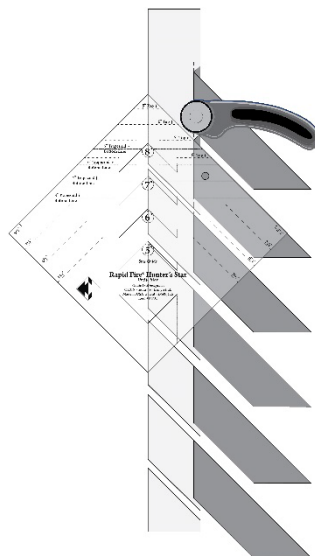
6. **Press** toward the Trapezoids.



7. **Repeat** for all (22) Background HWOFF Strips, placing (6) "like" fabric Trapezoids of each. Creating (22) Trapezoid HWOFF Strip Sets.

8. **Lay** one of the pressed Trapezoid HWOFF Strip Sets on the cutting mat.

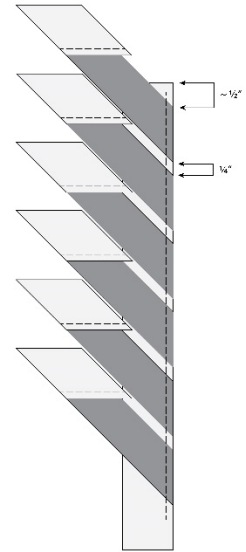
**Position** the diagonal line on the tool on the raw edge of the diamond strip and align the edge of the Rapid Fire Petite Hunter Star (RFPHS) tool with the long edge of each trapezoid. **Cut** the Trapezoid sections apart using the Rapid Fire Petite Hunter Star (RFPHS) tool to cut through the Diamond Strip. **Repeat** with all Trapezoid Strip Sets.



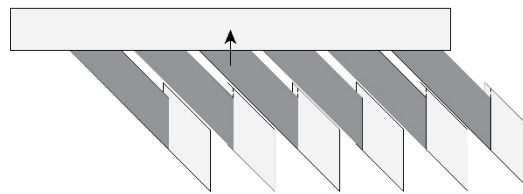

9. **Gather** the remaining (11) 2 ¼” Background Strips (Diamond). Sub cut them into (22) HWOF Strips.

10. **Position** the Trapezoid pieced units right sides together with the strips. Align the unsewn side of the trapezoid unit to the Background Strips. **Position** the first pieced Trapezoid unit down approximately ½” from the end of the strip and continue placing the remainder of the Trapezoid pieced units, leaving a ¼” gap between each unit when stitching. This time, leave 2 ¼” at the end of the strip. **Stitch** using an accurate ¼” seam allowance. You should be able to place (6) “like” fabric Trapezoids on each of the HWOF Background Strips.



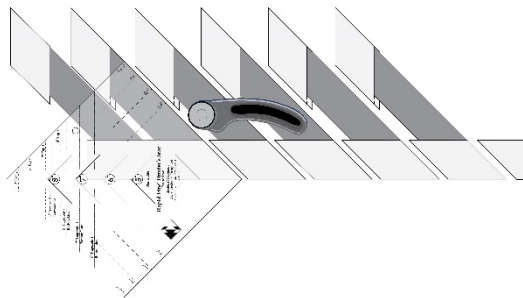
11. **Repeat** for all (22) Background HWOF Strips, placing (6) “like” fabric Trapezoids of each. Creating (22) Trapezoid HWOF Strip Sets.



12. **Press** toward the Background Strip.

13. **Lay** one of the pressed Trapezoid strip sets on the cutting mat. **Position** the diagonal line on the tool on the raw edge of the diamond strip and align the edge of the Rapid Fire Petite Hunter Star (RFPHS) tool with the long edge of each trapezoid. **Cut** the Trapezoid sections apart using the Rapid Fire Petite Hunter Star (RFPHS) tool to cut through the Diamond Strip. **Repeat** with all Trapezoid Strip Sets.
