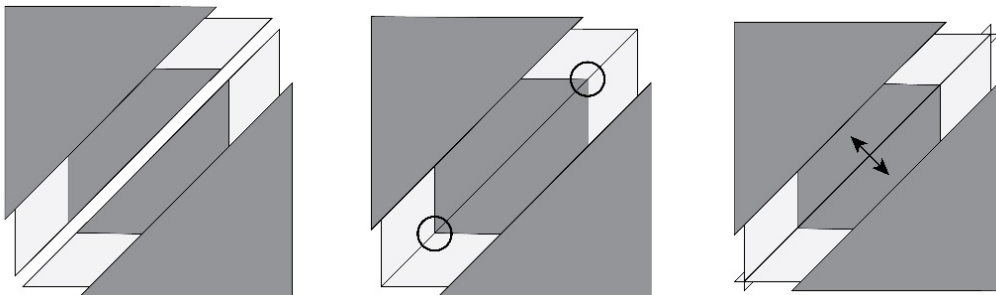


MODERN VICTORIAN HUNTER STAR REVIVAL ~ BY MICHELLE RENEE HIATT

CONSTRUCTION OF THE HUNTER STAR BLOCKS

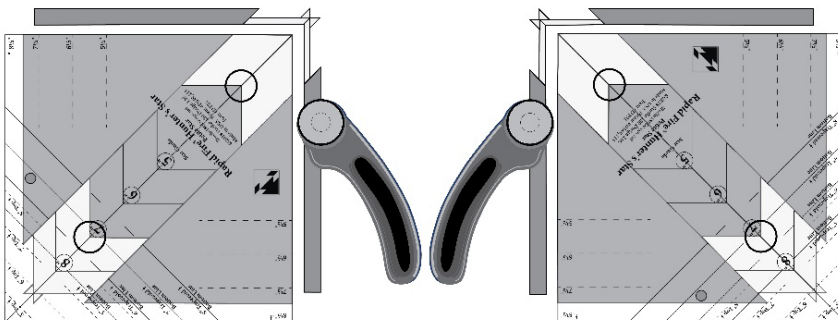
17. **Pair and position** the Pieced Triangle Units into preferred design sets. Given that you have (11) different fabrics, you will want to mix and match your paired sets, providing an assortment of Blocks. **Divide** the (132) Pieced Triangle Units into (2) stacks of (66). **Pair** each of the (66) Pieced Triangle Units with another non-matching Pieced Triangle Unit along their diagonal edge. **Place** right sides together and carefully **align** the points of the trapezoids (see circles on the diagram). Don't be concerned about aligning the outside edges of the large triangles as you will be trimming away the excess from those edges. **Stitch** with an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. **Press** all the seams open. You will have (66) Hunter Star Blocks (2 extra which will help when laying out the quilt).



18. **Trim** the Hunter Star Block to the prior sizing of 7" finished/ 7 1/2" cut with the Rapid Fire Petite Hunter Star. **Align** the center line of the Rapid Fire Petite Hunter Star with the center seam of the block while **aligning** the Diamond seam lines with the seam lines of the diamonds of the pieced block. **Align** the opposite end of the fabric trapezoid with size 7 Star Guide on the tool (shown with circles).

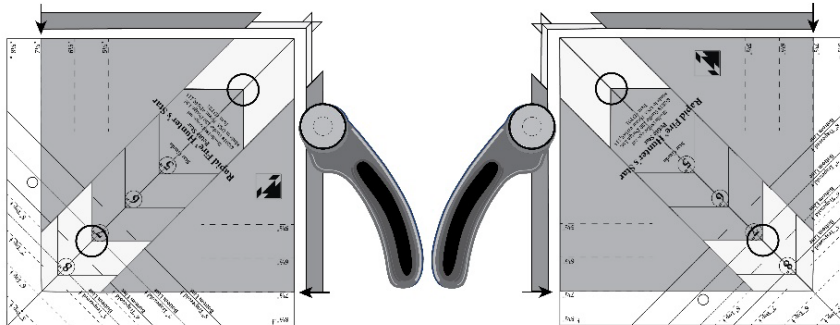

19. **Rotate** the Hunter Star Block 180 degrees and **align** the just-trimmed edge of the Block with the 7 ½” dotted lines while **aligning** the center seam and the Diamond seam lines of the tool with the Block. **Trim** the remaining two sides of the Block.

20. **Repeat** for the (66) Hunter Star Blocks which will now measure 7 ½” x 7 ½”.
