Do you have flower ideas floating around in your brain? Let's explore some design options for custom flowers, and sharpen our improv piecing skills, where straight or curved lines are rotary cut freely, then pieced without seam allowances. We will touch on machine appliqué for the flower centers and discuss techniques for transferring proportions from the design wall to your patchwork. Play with improvisational piecing, where straight or curved lines are rotary cut without a pattern, and then pieced without seam allowances. Explore design options to customize and individualize flowers, use an overlay to preserve the proportions you've established on the design wall, and machine appliqué for irregular circles to complete the center of your flowers.
