Pre-cutting Instructions:

In flying geese, the larger triangle is the "goose" and the 2 smaller triangles are the "sky". In the pattern, all "sky" fabric is the same background fabric.

Method 1: Cut (1) 3 ¾" x 6 ¾" rectangle goose fabric. Cut (2) 3 ¾" squares sky fabric.

Method 2: Cut (1) square 7 ¾" goose fabric. Cut (4) 4 ¼" squares sky fabric.

Method 3: Cut (1) square 7 ¾" goose fabric. Cut (4) 4 ¼" squares sky fabric.

Method 4: Cut (1) 7 ½" square goose fabric. Cut (1) 9" square sky fabric.

Method 5: Cut (1) 3 ¾" x 6 ¾" rectangle goose fabric. Cut (2) 4" squares sky fabric.

Feel free to bring a little extra fabric in case of miscuts, or to sew more flying geese units as time allows.
