The Crossworks block gets its name from the Westalee Crosshair Square marking tools, which serve as the foundation for creating the beautiful designs in this block. Explore the unique nature of the Westalee Spin-E-Fex style of templates, from rotating designs to borders and echoes. Workshop topics include basic rulerwork setup essentials, how to move the quilt when using templates, how to connect designs so you can complete larger design sections in one go, and how 1-2 templates can create a wide variety of designs with just small variations in use. Quilting templates help you achieve cleaner and smoother quilting lines and offer endless versatility. Join Sew Steady national educator Kate Quinn to add this unique skill to your quilting toolkit.

It also covers a usage fee for 2 loaner templates: a spin-e-fex template and a straight edge template, Clover Chaco liners, crosshair square marking tools, spacing gauges, and freemotion gliders.
