Make a traditional quilt block, the Log Cabin, in a non-traditional way. Use free-form cutting to control the look and design of the quilt blocks. Decisions on the next color and strip size/shape are made as the block is built. No need to have a plan, in fact, you will be more creative without one! Just pick a strip and sew! Marge covers free-form cutting, liberated sewing or sew-as-you-go, as well as design and composition.

- 1/8 yd. of (10-12) different fabrics - jelly Rolls, fat quarters, or scraps are also fine (Prep for class: pre-cut some of your fabric into strips in a variety of strip widths, from 3/4" wide up to 3" or 3 1/2" wide.)
