Please bring the following items to class:

- **[Basic Sewing Supplies](#)**
- 3 yds. of background fabric
- (12) Fat quarters (18" x 22")
- 4½ yds. fusible interfacing (at least 20" wide)
- Pinking Shears
- Hemostats for turning OR other tools for turning pieces right sides out and getting points out
- A wooden rolling iron to press "Pumpkin Seed"
- A pencil or marking tool that will show up on the background fabric and the backs of the fat quarters (18" x 22")
- The Pumpkin Seed portion of the block appliqued to the background
- A square ruler at least 9½" or larger for squaring up
