- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (5) fat quarter (18" x 22") – (1) for each flower with each fat quarter cut into (4) strips at 3½" x 22"
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") – flower centers cut into (4) strips at 3½" x 22"
- (1¼) yd. – Background (will be enough for binding as well)
- Cut (4) strips 3½" x WOF (width of fabric) before class from background yardage
