What a fun use of the Wing Clipper I and Tucker Trimmer! Learn a variation of the Geese on Edge technique. Start with a simple square, add logs, add a goose, and repeat. There are lots of possible variations! Birds on a Wire pattern offers five sizes and ten different variations using the same technique and fabric. If you want a larger quilt, you can just add more blocks. This is a fabulous project to use up scraps!

For Wall Size (shown):

- Assorted Brights – (12) Fat Eighths or (6) Fat Quarters or 1 ½ Yards of Assorted Scraps
- Background – 2 ½ Yards
- Accent Background (Dark) - 5/8 Yard

No matter what size you select, please bring the following to class:

Units	Fabric	Bring to Class
Large Half Square Triangles (HSTs) for HSTs D	Assorted Bright	(8) 4 1/2" Squares, from different fabrics, sub cut diagonally into (16) HSTs
Small Half Square Triangles (HSTs) for HSTs A B and C	Assorted Bright	Subcut the (24) 3 1/4" Squares, from multiple fabrics, sub cut diagonally into (48) HSTs
Starter Square	Assorted Bright	(8) 2" Squares, from different fabrics
Log #1	Background	(8) 1 1/2" x 2" Rectangles
Log #2	Background	(8) 1 1/2" x 3" Rectangles
Log #3	Accent Background (Dark)	(8) 1 1/2" x 3" Rectangles
Log #4	Accent Background (Dark)	(8) 1 1/2" x 4" Rectangles
Log #5	Background	(8) 1 1/2" x 4" Rectangles
Log #6	Background	(8) 1 1/2" x 5" Rectangles
Log #7	Background	(8) 2" x 5" Rectangles
Log #8	Background	(8) 2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles
