Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Thread snips
- (15) sheets of unlined paper
- (4) Quilt sandwiches from quality fabric and batting (about 14" square or so). 1¾ yd. of fabric will yield 6 sandwiches; no odd bits and pieces please, they are too hard to quilt. Fabric should be solid or near solid so that you can see your stitches, no prints. Your sandwiches will have 3 layers: fabric, batting, fabric. A thin batting works best. Baste layers together using your preferred method.
- Blue wash out marker **OR** white marker if your fabric is dark
- (4) paper towels
- Other free-motion quilting supplies that you like: slider, gloves, etc. (Quality supplies available for purchase in class)

Optional:

An optional kit is available and includes: (4) quilt sandwiches, quality cotton fabric and batting. **\$16**
