- (9) 9" x 22" fat eighths **OR** scraps to equal (72) 4½" X 2½" pieces - Dresden Wheels
- (5) 18" x 22" fat quarters - background, select light-colored fabrics (non-directional print)
- (2) 9" x 22" fat eighths - background, select light-colored fabrics (non-directional print)
- ⅓ yd. - background, select light-colored fabrics (non-directional print)
- (1) 18" x 22" fat quarter - bike frame
- (1) 18" x 22" fat quarter - bike basket
- (1) 9" x 22" fat eighth **OR** scraps to equal (1) 12" square - bike parts
- (4 to 5) 9" x 22" fat eighths - floral fabrics, leaves, and vines (flowers, approx. 1" to 3")
- ¾ yd. Stitch Witchery fusible web
- 1 yd. Misty Fuse fusible web
- 10-degree wedge ruler (Mini Wedge from Phillips Fiber Art)
- Silicone pressing sheet **OR** parchment paper
- Clover Fusible Bias Tape Maker 1" (25mm) Art. #4015
- Clover Fusible Bias Tape Maker ¾" (9 mm) Art. #4012
- Steam-A-Seam® 2 in ¼" wide
