Students will learn freezer paper foundation piecing while stitching this Alaska-inspired circular wallhanging. Made from 4 different blocks and one fussy-cut center design, it includes a tiny tree, a little house, and a mountains and valleys outer border. Gail stitched her Midnight Sun using scraps from her stash, except for the outer border hand-dyes. A selection of fat quarters, some fussy cuts, and some fat eighth packs of hand-dyes can be pre-ordered. Registration for this class includes show admission for Friday.

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - light background fabric
- (3) fat quarters (18" x 22") - fabric for houses
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - green fabric for trees
- (3) fat quarters (18" x 22") - fabric for inner star
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - fabric for meadow
- Scrap pieces - tree trunks, house trim, windows, and doors
- Fabric to Fussy Cut Center
- Freezer Paper (18" X 36")
- 6" **OR** 12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler
- 4" Square rotary cutting ruler
- 1" X 6" **OR** 12" Ruler

\*Additional fabric needed to complete the project at home\*

- (2) 1 yd. pieces of background fabric
- (8) fat quarters - hand-dyed gradations
- ¼ yd. accent fabric (lime green)
