Precutting Instructions:

Precutting must be done before class, as there will not be class time available for cutting.

- (5) 4.5" squares - Color A, non directional print
- (16) 4" squares - Color B, non directional print
- (32) 4" squares - Color C (low volume color), non directional print
- (2) 3.5" x 14.5" strips - Color C for borders
- (2) 3.5 x 20.5" strips - Color C for borders
