In this class, you will learn the basics of how to make a Hawaiian Style quilt using fused appliqué and machine quilting techniques. In the class, you will start with a smaller, die cut project that is provided in the class kit. You will make a smaller project and focus on finishing appliqué projects by machine. - (2) Pieces of pre-washed, dried, and ironed fabric that is 40" X 40" square minimum in (2) contrasting colors
- A second background if you feel up to the challenge of making (2) wallhangings
